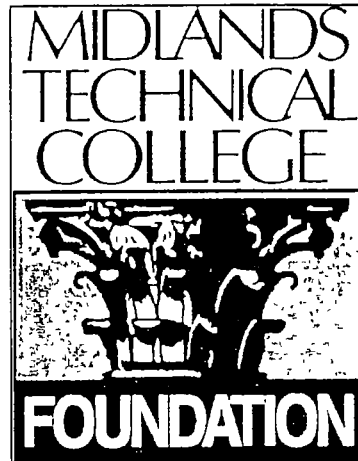

## ARTICLE I NAME, PURPOSE AND MEMBERSHIP

### Section 1 - Name

The name of the Foundation shall be Midlands Technical College Foundation; hereinafter referred to as the "Foundation."

### Section 2 - Purpose

The purpose of the Foundation is set forth in the Articles of Incorporation. Specifically, the Foundation is an exclusively educational and charitable Foundation for the purpose of supporting education at Midlands Technical College (MTC). The Foundation may bestow scholarships to MTC students; awards to MTC students and faculty members, and gifts to Midlands Technical College by establishing instructor chairs, financing special courses, purchasing equipment and buildings; and such other methods as the Midlands Technical College Foundation Board of Trustees, hereinafter referred to as "Board of Trustees," may find desirable.

### Section 3 - Funding

The Foundation shall acquire funds by solicitation by mail and email, events, personal contact or otherwise; and may accept money or other property by *inter vivos* gift or by will, including conditional gifts, whenever the Board of Trustees shall deem that the acceptance of such gift and such conditions is within the purpose of the Foundation.

### Section 4 - Membership

Membership in the Foundation shall be open to any person as prescribed in Article III.

### Section 5 - Offices

The principal office of the Foundation shall be at Midlands Technical College, Columbia, South Carolina, or at such other or additional places within Richland and Lexington counties, in the State of South Carolina, as the Board of Trustees may designate.

## ARTICLE II POWERS OF FOUNDATION

### Section 1 - Powers

As a means of accomplishing the foregoing purposes, the Foundation shall have the following powers:

- (a) To accept, acquire, receive, take and hold by bequest, devise, grant, gift, purchase, exchange, lease, transfer, judicial order or decree, or otherwise, for any of its objects and purposes, any property, both real and personal, of whatever kind, nature, or description and wherever situated,
- (b) To seal, exchange, convey, mortgage, lease, transfer, or otherwise dispose of any such property, both real and personal, as the objects and purposes of the Foundation may require, subject to such limitations as may be prescribed by law;
- (c) To borrow money and, from time to time, to make, accept, endorse, execute, and issue bonds, debentures, promissory notes, bills of exchange, and other obligations of the Foundation for monies borrowed, or in payment for property acquired, or for any of the

other purposes of the Foundation, and to secure the payment of any such obligations by mortgage, pledge, deed, indenture, agreement, or other instrument of trust, or by other lien upon assignment of, or agreement in regard to all or any part of the property, rights, privileges of the Foundation wherever situated, whether now owned or hereafter to be acquired,

- (d) To invest or reinvest its funds in such stock, common or preferred bonds, debentures, mortgages, investment partnerships, real estate, intellectual property or in such other securities and property as the Board of Trustees shall deem advisable, subject to the limitations and conditions contained in any bequest, devise, grant, or gift, provided such limitations and conditions are not in conflict with the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations as they now exist, or as they may hereafter be amended.

- (e) Any and all other powers as approved by three quarters of the Board of Trustees.

## **Section 2 - Limitations and Conditions**

In general, and subject to such limitations and conditions as are, or may be, prescribed by law, to exercise such other powers that now are, or hereafter may be, conferred by law upon a corporation organized for the purpose herein above set forth, or necessary or incidental to the powers so conferred, or conducive to the attainment of the purposes of the Foundation, subject to the further limitation and condition that, notwithstanding any other provision of this certificate, only such powers shall be exercised as are in furtherance of the tax-exempt purposes of the Foundation and as may be exercised by an organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations as they now exist, or as they may hereafter be amended, and by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of such code and regulations as they now exist, or as they may hereafter be amended

# **ARTICLE III BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

## **Section 1 - Board of Trustees**

The Board of Trustees shall be the governing body of the Foundation and shall consist of up to twenty-five (25) members. In addition, the Chairperson of the Midlands Technical College Commission, the President of Midlands Technical College, the Vice President for Business Affairs the Chief Executive Officer of the Foundation, and others as designated, shall serve in an ex-officio capacity without voting privileges.

The Trustees of the Board shall serve terms of three (3) years and may be reelected to one successive term. After one-year absence from the Board of Trustees, a former member may serve two (2) additional three-year terms for a total of four (4) terms

The terms of three (3) years for each Trustee shall be staggered such that a third, or approximation thereof, of the service is scheduled to end each year. Procedures will be as follows:

- a) The Governance Committee of the Foundation Board will submit a roster of names during the third quarterly meeting of each year, or at other times during the year at the consent of the Foundation Board of each year from which the Board will elect new and/or continuing members

- b) Terms will begin on the first day of each fiscal year and end on the final day of the third fiscal year. Trustees filling an unexpired term may begin when elected and subsequently be elected to two (2) full three-year terms.
- c) The Trustees shall serve without compensation

Term limit exceptions can be made given the following conditions.

- a) If a Foundation Trustee has significant experience and, due to circumstances beyond the board's control, no one of comparable experience is available to serve as an officer of the Board, then a member's term may be extended one additional three (3) year term to provide continuity leadership to the Foundation
- b) Additionally, an exception can be made in the required absence from the Board of Trustees to accommodate the term limit exceptions. Therefore, under these exceptions, which should be rare, a member may serve up to five (5) consecutive terms.

#### **Section 2 - Meetings**

The Board shall meet quarterly or at the call of the Chairperson of the Board of Trustees, or upon demand by six other voting members of the Board. Members must attend at least seventy-five percent (75%) of the regular quarterly meetings during each calendar year, or their resignation may be requested by the Chairperson of the Board based on the recommendation of the Executive or Governance Committee.

If, due to compelling professional or personal reasons, a Trustee requires an extended absence from the Board, the Trustee can request a six (6) month leave of absence from Board duties. The request is submitted to the Chairperson of the Board of Trustees who, in consultation with the appropriate Committee Chair (s), can grant the request. An additional request of six (6) months can be requested for a total of one year leave of absence. A leave of absence will not extend the Trustees term of service and if the term will end during a requested absence, the request will not be granted.

#### **Section 3 - Notice of Meetings**

Written notice of meetings, giving the time and place thereof, shall be given at least seven days prior to such meeting and may be sent by regular mail and/or email or by other appropriate means

#### **Section 4 - Quorum**

Fifty percent (50%) of the voting members of the Board of Trustees shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The Trustees present at a duly called or held meeting at which a quorum is present may continue to transact business until adjournment, notwithstanding the withdrawal of enough Trustees to leave less than a quorum present

### **Section 5 - Proxy Voting**

When a member of the Board cannot attend a meeting, he/she may authorize another member of the Foundation Board to cast his/her ballot provided.

- (a) The absent Board member has been informed of the issues to be considered, and
- (b) A signed statement by the absent member is presented authorizing the designated person to cast his/her vote.

### **Section 6 - Mail or Fax Vote**

When a situation arises that requires the action of the full Board between the scheduled meeting dates and a special meeting is not required, a mail/fax/email or other appropriate means vote may be utilized. Such a vote must be ratified at the next regular meeting of the Board and designated in the minutes.

### **Section 7 - Board Minutes**

Minutes that accurately reflect the events of each meeting will be prepared by or under the direction of the Secretary and placed in a permanent book, which will be maintained in the principal office of the Foundation.

### **Section 8 - Resignation, Removal and Vacancies**

A Trustee may resign at any time by giving written notice to the Chairperson of the Board of Trustees. A Trustee may be removed for cause by the vote of a majority of the entire Board of Trustees eligible to vote, at a meeting called for such purpose at which a quorum is present. Whenever a vacancy occurs by reason of resignation, removal for cause, or death, the Governance Committee may nominate a successor to fill the unexpired term of the vacant position on the Board of Trustees.

## **ARTICLE IV POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD**

Without prejudice to the general powers that may be exercised by the Foundation under its Articles of Incorporation and under Article II, the Board shall have the following specific powers and duties:

### **Section 1 - Appointment of Agents**

To appoint and, at its discretion, remove such officers or agents as it shall deem proper, and to prescribe their duties.

### **Section 2 - Committees**

To appoint from time to time suitable committees not established elsewhere in the Bylaws to investigate or discharge any functions assigned by the Board. Such committees shall report to the Board when and as directed.

### **Section 3 - Policies**

To approve Foundation Bylaws and those policies needed for proper and fiduciary functioning of the Board, committees, committee members, staff and others representing the Foundation.

#### **Section 4 - Business Transactions**

To sue and be sued, complain and defend in its corporate name, to borrow money and give its notes or other obligations therefore, to pledge, encumber, or mortgage any property it may own, to sell convey, or dispose of any property it may own; to receive and administer funds for scientific and educational purposes, to receive, take title to, hold and use the proceeds and income of stocks, bonds, obligations, or other securities; to take and hold by bequest, devise, gift, purchase, or lease, either absolutely or in trust, any property, real, personal, or mixed, without limitation as to amount or value; to reject any or all gifts, benefits, or devises that it deems not in the best interest of the objectives and purposes of the Foundation No trustee or officer of the corporation shall have any liability for debts or obligations of the corporation, or for any act performed in good faith on behalf of the corporation

#### **Section 5 - Records**

To maintain records of Board proceedings and of the activities of its committees, officers, and agents

#### **Section 6 - Reports**

To cause to be prepared annually in writing and to distribute a report of the business and activities of the Foundation The Board of Trustees shall cause an audit to be made of the financial affairs of the Foundation no less than annually and at any other time as may be deemed necessary. Reports of such audits shall be made available to any member of the Foundation and to the public upon demand during normal working hours

### **ARTICLE V OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES**

#### **Section 1 - Officers**

The principal officers of the Foundation shall be Chairperson of the Board, Vice-Chairperson of the Board, Secretary, and Treasurer The subordinate officers shall consist of such other officers, assistant officers and agents as may be deemed necessary and as are elected or appointed by the Board of Trustees The same person may hold any two or more offices Principal officers shall be selected from among the elected Trustees.

#### **Section 2 - Election, Term of Office and Qualifications**

The principal officers shall be chosen annually by the Board of Trustees at its annual meeting or as soon thereafter as conveniently possible. Subordinate officers may be elected or appointed by the Board of Trustees or may be appointed by the Chairperson or any other principal officer to whom the Chairperson of the Board of Trustees shall delegate the authority of appointment. Each officer shall hold office until his successor is chosen and qualified, or until his death, his resignation, or his removal, whichever event shall first occur. Election or appointment of an officer or agent shall not of itself create any contractual rights. An individual may not serve in the office of Chairperson or Vice-Chairperson for more than four consecutive one-year terms. Not included in this limitation shall be any partial term served to fill a vacancy

#### **Section 3 - Removal of Officers**

The Board of Trustees may remove any officer or agent whenever in its judgment the best interests of the Foundation will be served by so doing. Notwithstanding the foregoing, any subordinate officer or agent may also be removed by the Chairperson, or by any other principal officer having authority to designate or appoint the officer or agent to be removed, with or

without cause. Any removal shall be without prejudice to the contract rights, if any, of the person so removed.

#### **Section 4 - Powers and Duties of the Chairperson**

The Chairperson of the Board shall preside at the annual meeting of the Foundation and at all meetings of the Board of Trustees, shall appoint members of all committees and the chairpersons thereof, and shall perform such duties as the Board of Trustees may from time to time assign to the Chairperson of the Board and such other duties as are usual to this office. The Chairperson shall be an ex-officio member of all standing and special committees of the Board unless otherwise specified by the Board. The Chairperson shall be selected from elected Trustees who are not officials of the College or its Area Commission.

#### **Section 5 - Powers and Duties of the Vice-Chairperson**

The Vice-Chairperson shall possess the powers and perform the duties of the Chairperson in the absence or disability of the Chairperson. The Vice-Chairperson shall do and perform such other duties as may be from time to time assigned to him/her by the Chairperson of the Board.

#### **Section 6 - Powers and Duties of the Secretary**

The Secretary shall attend all meetings of the Board and shall keep or cause to be kept the minutes of the proceedings of such meetings. Custody of the seal of the Foundation shall be kept in the principal office of the Foundation, and the Secretary is authorized to affix, or cause to be affixed, the same to all instruments requiring its use. The Secretary shall be responsible for maintaining the files and records of the Foundation and for such other duties as the Board of Trustees may prescribe.

#### **Section 7 - Powers and Duties of the Treasurer**

The Treasurer shall be responsible for the receipt and disbursement of all assets of the Foundation in accordance with Board of Trustees direction, and for ensuring that accurate records of all activities are maintained. Funds, books and other records of this office shall at all times be subject to the inspection, supervision and control of the Board of Trustees. The Treasurer will cause to be performed annually an independent audit of the Foundation books and records, and submit same to the Board of Trustees. Disbursement of funds of the Foundation will be made only upon signature of the Treasurer and/or the Chairperson or such other persons as the Board of Trustees may direct in writing. The Treasurer shall make reports of the finances of the Foundation to the Chairperson and the Board of Trustees as required or requested and shall perform such other duties as may be required of him/her by the Board of Trustees.

#### **Section 8 - Powers and Duties of Committee Chairpersons**

The Chairperson of each committee shall organize, call, issue agendas for, and preside over all meetings of his/her respective committee. The Committee Chairperson shall be responsible for discharging the tasks assigned to the committee. Each Committee Chairperson shall provide appropriate reports and recommendations to the Executive Committee for consideration and action.

#### **Section 9 - Standing Committees**

- (a) The Standing Committees of the Foundation are the Executive Committee, Advancement Committee, Financial Affairs and Administration Committee, and Governance Committee. Each Standing Committee of the Foundation shall have the

responsibility and authority to conduct specific tasks assigned to the Committee as described in the charter for each committee. These tasks shall be assigned as part of the Foundation's Bylaws, in approved policies of the Foundation, or by action of the Executive Committee or the Board of Trustees. Standing Committees are responsible for the initial review of proposed policies, procedures, and other actions in their area of responsibility and shall, as appropriate, make recommendations to the Executive Committee on these issues.

- (b) *Executive Committee*: The Executive Committee shall perform its duties as directed in the Executive Committee Charter. The Charter may be amended from time to time.
- (c) *Advancement Committee*: The Advancement Committee shall perform its duties as directed in the Advancement Committee Charter. The Charter may be amended from time to time.
- (d) *Financial Affairs and Administration Committee*: The Financial Affairs and Administration Committee shall perform its duties as directed in the Financial Affairs and Administration Committee Charter. The Charter may be amended from time to time.
- (e) *Governance Committee*: The Governance Committee shall perform its duties as directed in the Governance Committee Charter. The Charter may be amended from time to time.
- (f) *Ad Hoc Committees*: The Board of Trustees may from time to time establish other committees, with such powers and authority as the Board of Trustees may approve. The Chairperson shall appoint the members of such committees from among the Board of Trustees or such other persons as the Chairperson shall select.

#### **Section 10 - Chief Executive Officer**

The Board of Trustees, in consultation with the College President, will have the authority to hire, employ, and terminate a Foundation Chief Executive Officer who will be responsible for the efficient day-to-day operation of the Foundation and for its effectiveness and success.

He/she shall be responsible for ensuring that the resolutions and actions of the Board of Trustees are carried into effect, and for reporting to the Board of Trustees on the conduct and management of the affairs of the Foundation.

### **ARTICLE VI CONTRACTS AND CONTROL OF FUNDS**

#### **Section 1 - Contracts**

The Board of Trustees, except as may be otherwise provided in these Bylaws, may authorize any officer or officers, agent or agents, to enter into any contract, or execute and deliver any instrument in the name of, and on behalf of the Foundation, and such authority may be general or confined to specific instances. Unless so authorized, no officer, agent or employee shall have any power or authority to bind the Foundation by any contract or engagement or to pledge its credit or to render it financially liable for any purpose or in any amount.



## **Section 2 - Loans**

No loans shall be contracted on behalf of the Foundation and no negotiable paper shall be issued in its name, unless and except as authorized by the Board of Trustees. When so authorized by the Board of Trustees, any officer or agent of the Foundation may effect loans and advances at any time for the Foundation from any bank, trust company, or other institutions, or from any firm, corporation or individual, and for such loans and advances may make, execute and deliver promissory notes, bonds or other evidences of indebtedness of the Foundation, and when authorized as aforesaid, as security for the payment of any and all loans, advances, indebtedness, and liabilities of the Foundation, may pledge, hypothecate or transfer any and all stocks,

securities and other personal property at any time held by the Foundation, and to that end endorse, assign and deliver the same, and may mortgage any particular piece of real property held by the Foundation when specifically so authorized by the Board of Trustees.

## **Section 3 - Deposits**

All funds of the Foundation shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of the Foundation with such banks, bankers, trust companies or other depositaries as the Board of Trustees may select or as may be selected by any officer or officers, agent or agents of the Foundation to whom such power may be delegated from time to time by the Board of Trustees, and as described in the Foundation's Policies and Procedures. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Bylaws, the Board of Trustees may enter into an appropriate agreement with any bank, trust company, or similar institution of its choosing for the management, investment, disbursement and bookkeeping related to the assets of the Foundation or a portion of them, or any portion of the duties assigned the Treasurer as the Board may deem desirable to assign to such institution. Such assignment of duties to such institution shall not relieve the Treasurer from performing the remaining duties assigned him/her by these Bylaws or by the Board of Trustees.

## **Section 4 - Checks, Drafts, etc.**

All checks, drafts, or other orders for the payments of money, notes, acceptances, or other evidences of indebtedness issued in the name of the Foundation shall be signed by such officer or officers, agent or agents, of the Foundation and in such manner as shall be determined from time to time by resolution of the Board of Trustees, and as described in the Foundation's Policies and Procedures. Endorsements for deposit to the credit of the Foundation in any of its duly authorized depositaries may be made, without counter-signature, by the Chairperson or Vice-Chairperson, or the Treasurer, or by any other officer or agent of the Foundation to whom the Board of Trustees, by resolution, shall have delegated such power, or by hand-stamped impression in the name of the Foundation.

## **Section 5 - General and Special Bank Accounts**

The Board of Trustees from time to time may authorize the opening and keeping of general and special bank accounts with such banks, trust companies or other depositories as the Board of Trustees may select and may make such rules and regulations with respect thereto, not inconsistent with the provisions of these Bylaws, as they may deem expedient.

## **ARTICLE VII FISCAL YEAR**

### **Section 1 - Fiscal Year**

The fiscal year of the Foundation shall be consistent with the state fiscal year beginning July 1 and ending June 30

## **ARTICLE VIII AMENDMENTS**

### **Section 1 - Amendments**

These Bylaws may be altered, amended or repealed and new Bylaws may be adopted at any meeting of the Board of Trustees with a quorum present, by the affirmative vote of a majority of the entire Board of Trustees eligible to vote.

## **ARTICLE IX DISSOLUTION**

### **Section 1 - Dissolution**

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the Foundation will be turned over to one or more organizations that themselves are exempt from Federal Income Tax as organizations described in Sections 501(c) (3) and 170 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provisions of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the federal, state or local government for exclusively public purposes, provided that this section is irrevocable notwithstanding any other provision of these Bylaws.
