**REQUEST FOR ABATEMENT OF EXCISE TAXES, PENALTIES AND INTEREST

This abatement statement is attached to the Form 4720 filed by the DARBAKER LEASURE K - U/W (the "Trust"). The Trust hereby requests abatement of the entire amount reported on the Form 4720 in accordance with section 4962 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code")¹ on the basis that the Trust's failures to act, which gave rise to these taxes, penalties and interest, were based on reasonable cause and not the result of willful neglect. The Trust also hereby requests abatement of the penalties for late filing of the Form 990-PF in accordance with section 6652 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986,

The current trustee of the Trust is BNY Mellon, N.A (the "Trustee"). The Trust was established to support the University of Pittsburgh School of Pharmacy, Ohio Northern University School of Pharmacy and Lancaster Theological Seminary. Originally, the Trust was classified as a supporting organization under section 509(a)(3) of the Code. The Trustee believed that the Trust continued to qualify as a supporting organization subsequent to the changes enacted by the Pension Protection Act. Thus, the Trust did not make sufficient distributions to satisfy the requirements under section 4942 of the Code. The Trustee recently undertook a comprehensive analysis of all of its supporting organizations. As part of that process, the Trustee determined that the Trust did not qualify as a supporting organization and should instead be reclassified as a private foundation. Based on this analysis, the Trustee then distributed all amounts that should have been distributed pursuant to section 4942 of the Code. The Trustee represents that, to its knowledge, the Trust has not engaged in any violations of sections 4941, 4943, 4944, or 4945 of the Code.

The Trust is now filing the unfiled Forms 990-PF that were not filed during the period the Trust was thought to be a supporting organization. The Trust filed the Forms 990 as it should have for a supporting organization on a timely basis.

On the basis of the Trustee's good-faith belief that the Trust continued to qualify as a supporting organization under section 509(a)(3) of the Code, the Trust's distribution of all funds required by section 4942 of the Code, and the Trust's self-reporting of the same, the Trust now requests abatement of any taxes for amounts reported on this IRS 4720 and of any penalties for late filing of the Form 990-PF on the basis that failure to distribute is due to reasonable cause and not to willful neglect within the meaning of sections 4962 and 6652 of the Code.
