Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 15 - An independent consultant was engaged to collect and analyze comparability data to review the reasonableness of compensation when the first President and CEO was originally hired. The data was reviewed by the Board Chair, who determined that the compensation was reasonable based on the data compiled. The data was reviewed by the board of directors, who approved the compensation. The compensation of the organization's current President, who succeeded the first President and CEO on October 31, 2012, is considerably lower than that paid to the first President and CEO. To determine the reasonableness of the compensation for the General Counsel and COO, the President and CEO consulted the most recent compensation survey published by the Michigan Nonprofit Association. She then presented the finding and compensation recommendations to the organization's Compensation Committee which approved the recommended compensation.
