Each month, many older adults in northeast Indiana must decide between purchasing food, filling prescriptions, or paying utilities or rent. Their limited income or retirement savings do not cover all their necessary living expenses. SeniorPak eases the decision for area senior citizens because they know they can count on SeniorPak and its 20+ pound bag of groceries every two weeks to supplement their food budget. SeniorPak ensures that homebound older adults over 60 years of age living on limited incomes have help with their food needs.

The Farm Wagon delivers fresh and shelf-stable food to rural and low-income city neighborhoods where people who may not have access to that quality of nutritious food live. Initiated in October 1999, the Farm Wagon visits sites in Adams, Allen, DeKalb, Huntington, LaGrange, Noble, Wells, Whitley, and Steuben counties. The Farm Wagon program distributes over 1.5 million pounds of fresh produce and other perishables annually.
