I. STATEMENT OF POLICY

As a corporate citizen in the communities in which it operates, Western Digital (WD) recognizes a responsibility consistent with its business objectives to respond to the needs of the communities in which it operates and where its employees live. The quality of life and education, the well-being of our employees and their families, and the economic health of our society are of vital interest to our organization, its leadership, and staff. As such, WD has established charitable foundations to address global community needs on a regional basis.

The Western Digital Charitable Foundation, "WD Foundation", a California non-profit benefit corporation, was created in 1997 to support Western Digital's philanthropic activities that support economic, social, educational, and basic needs in our regional business communities within the United States. As such, WD Foundation grants are directed toward non-profit organizations in Orange, Santa Clara and Alameda Counties in California, and Boulder County, Colorado.
