# ARTS COUNCIL OF SOUTHWESTERN INDIANA, INC. By-Laws

# **ARTICLE I. Identity**

- 1.01 Name: The name of this corporation is the Arts Council of Southwestern Indiana, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the Arts Council.
- 1.02 Status: The Arts Council is a not-for-profit, non-stock corporation under statutes of the State of Indiana.
- 1.03 Registered Office: The Arts Council's principle office is to be located at 318 Main Street, Suite 101, Evansville, Indiana.

#### **ARTICLE II. Purpose and Objective**

- 2.01 Purpose: The purpose of the Arts Council is to stimulate, organize, promote, and advocate the arts and cultural life as permitted to be carried on by not-for-profit corporations under the laws of Indiana and the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, Section 501(c)(3) or the corresponding provisions of any future federal tax code.
- 2.02 Objective: The objective of the Arts Council is to enhance the quality of life in our community, raise awareness of the arts and the value of the arts in the southwestern region of Indiana, and advocate for both existing and future arts activities. The term "arts" is understood to include, but is not limited to, the performing, visual, literary, environmental, and other allied arts.

#### **ARTICLE III. Nonprofit Corporate Provisions**

- 3.01 Distribution of Earnings: No part of the net earnings of the Arts Council shall inure to the benefit of its members or other private persons, except that the Arts Council shall be authorized to pay for services rendered or costs incurred, and make distributions to further the purposes herein set forth.
- 3.02 Dissolution and distribution: Upon dissolution of the Arts Council, after paying or making provisions for payment of all liabilities of the Arts Council, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government, for any public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Arts Council is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court will determine which are organized and operated for such purposes.
- 3.03 Prohibition Against Lobbying and Political Campaigning: No substantial part of the activities of the Arts Council shall be given to the promulgation of propaganda or to

other means designed to influence legislation. The Arts Council shall not participate by any means in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

# **ARTICLE IV. Membership**

4.01 The Arts Council shall not have members as defined in Indiana Code chapter 23-17-7.

# **ARTICLE V. Board of Directors**

### 5. 01 Composition

The Board of Directors ("Board") shall be composed of not less than twelve (12) nor more than twenty-four (24) members.

### 5.02 Responsibilities and Duties

- a. The Board shall have the overall responsibility for the management and administration of the affairs, funds and property of the Arts Council and for setting all policies, procedures and direction consistent with the laws of Indiana and the By-Laws of the Arts Council.
- b. The Board shall also have the power to appoint such subordinate officers, employees, or agents as may be necessary for the conduct of business and to designate their title and compensation, if any. To this end, the Board may engage an executive administrator(s), who shall carry out policies approved by the Board and who may, subject to the Board's approval, enter into contracts required for the conduct of business of the Board according to its policies.
- c. A Board member's responsibilities shall include, but are not limited to attendance at Board meetings, service on committees or task forces as assigned by the President, support of and participation in annual fundraising, and financial donation to the Arts Council at a level meaningful to the Board member.

#### 5.03 Terms of Service

Election to the Board shall be at the Annual Meeting upon the recommendation of the Nominating Committee. Such terms of office shall be for three (3) years, and become effective immediately. Directors may not be re-elected after two successive terms without a one-year break in service.

#### 5.04 Meetings of the Board

a. The Board member shall meet no less than six (6) times per year.

- b. At all meetings of the Board, business shall be transacted by a majority vote of all Board members present and any action so taken will be considered as the action of the full Board, unless otherwise required by these By-Laws.
- c. Special meetings of the Board may be called by the President or four (4) elected Board members. At least two (2) days' notice shall be given for special meetings. No business may be transacted other than that indicated in the notice of the special meeting.

#### 5.05 Quorum

A quorum of the Board shall consist of fifty percent plus 1 (50% + 1) of the total number of Board members.

#### 5.06 Vacancies

A vacancy on the Board caused by death, resignation, removal or otherwise may be filled for the unexpired term by two-thirds of the full Board vote upon the recommendation of the Nominating Committee. The appointment shall not count toward the eligible term or terms of Board membership.

#### 5.07 Removal

Three (3) consecutive unexcused absences from regularly scheduled Board meetings will be considered an automatic resignation from the Board. A Board member may be removed, by a vote of two-thirds of the full Board, for misconduct affecting the Arts Council. A Board member may also be removed, by a vote of two-thirds of the full Board, if it should reasonably appear that such Board member is unable or unwilling to meet the responsibilities and duties of Board membership as outlined in section 5.02.

#### 5.08 Standard of Care

- a. A Board member shall perform the duties of a director, including those as a member of any Board committee on which the Board member may serve, in good faith, in a manner such Board member believes to be in the best interest of the Arts Council and with such care, including reasonable inquiry, as an ordinarily prudent person in a like situation would use under similar circumstance.
- b. In performing the duties of a Board member, a Board member shall be entitled to rely on the information, opinions, reports or statements, including financial statements and other data, in each case prepared or presented by other Board members or employees, Board committees, counsel, accountants or other persons as to matters believed to be within such person's professional or expert competence, so long as the Board member acts in good faith after reasonable inquiry when the need therefore is indicated by the circumstances.

c. Except as provided elsewhere in these By-Laws, a person who performs the duties of a Board member in accordance with this section shall have no liability based upon any failure or alleged failure to discharge that person's obligations as a Board member, including, without limiting, any actions or omissions which exceed or defeat a public or charitable purpose to which a corporation, or assets held by it, are dedicated.

#### 5.09 Conflict of Interest

- a. Use of Knowledge: No Board member shall use his or her position, or the knowledge gained there from, in such a manner that a conflict between the interest of the organization or any of its affiliates and his or her personal interests arises.
- b. Interests of Corporation: Each Board member has a duty to place the interest of the Arts Council foremost in any dealings with the organization and has a continuing responsibility to comply with the requirements of this policy.
- c. No Material Interest: Board or committee members may not obtain for themselves, their relatives, or their friends a material interest of any kind from their association with the organization.
- d. Disclosure of Interest: If a Board member has an interest in a proposed transaction with the Arts Council in the form of a significant personal financial interest in the transaction or in any other organization involved in the transaction, or holds a position as trustee, director, or officer in any such other organization, he or she must make full disclosure of such interest before participating in any discussion or negotiation of such transaction.
- e. Absence from Discussion and Vote: Any Board member who is aware of a potential conflict of interest that member has with respect to any matter coming before the Board or committee shall not be present for any discussion of or vote in connection with the matter.

#### **ARTICLE VI. Officers**

#### 6.01 Composition

The officers shall consist of the President, President-Elect, Secretary and Treasurer.

#### 6.02 Election, Terms

The election of officers shall occur at the Annual Meeting. Officers shall serve for a term of no more than two (2) years or until their successors are elected and take office.

#### 6.03 Vacancies

Vacancies which occur in any office, regardless of reason, shall be filled by the Board for the unexpired term by a majority vote of the quorum present at meeting upon the recommendation of the Nominating Committee.

#### 6.04 Duties

The duties of the officers shall be such as usually pertain to their respective offices, and as are assigned to them by the Board.

#### a. President

The President shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Arts Council and represents the Board to agencies and the community. The President shall preside at meetings of the Arts Council, the Board, and the Executive Committee. The President shall appoint the members and the chairs of all Arts Council Committees, unless specified otherwise in the By-Laws.

#### b. President- Elect

The President-Elect shall assume all duties of the President in the President's absence and shall assist the President in fulfillment of executive duties, and shall serve as Chair for the Nominating Committee.

### c. Secretary

The Secretary shall ensure that the minutes of the Board meetings, including attendance, are kept and shall assist the President in fulfillment of other executive duties as prescribed.

#### d. Treasurer

The Treasurer shall be responsible for the development of the annual budget, and financial oversight insuring that fiscal records are kept, and that all funds are recorded, spent, and monitored consistent with funding and legal requirements and sound financial management. The books and

accounts of the Arts Council shall be open at all times during business hours to the inspection of any Board member of the Arts Council.

### **ARTICLE VII. Committees**

7.01 General: Committees have such functions and exercise such power of the Board as can lawfully be delegated, and to the extent provided from policies in creating such Committee or Committees. Committee chairs shall be a Board member and shall be appointed by the President. Meetings of Committees may be held without notice at such time and place determined by the Chair of the Committee. The Committee shall keep regular minutes of its proceedings and report these minutes to the Board when required.

7.02 The Executive Committee: The Executive Committee shall consist of all officers of the Arts Council, and the Executive Director of the Arts Council, ex-officio and without vote. The Executive Committee shall have the power to act on behalf of the Arts Council subject to final ratification of its acts by the Board.

#### 7.03 Standing Committees

Standing Committees of the Arts Council shall be as follows:

### a. Nominating Committee

- Composition: The Nominating Committee shall be composed of five (5) Board members. The Chair of the Committee shall be the President-Elect of the Arts Council.
- ii. Duties: The Nominating Committee shall present nominations for all Board members and for each office at the Annual Meeting. It shall also present nominations for the positions that become vacant during the year. The nominative slate shall be published within a reasonable time prior to the Annual Meeting.

#### b. Development Committee

- i. Composition: The Development Committee shall be composed of six (6) to ten (10) Board members.
- ii. Duties: The Development Committee is responsible for generating revenue, identifying potential donors, underwriters and other funders, fund-raising events or opportunities.

#### c. Finance Committee

- Composition: The Finance Committee shall be comprised of the Treasurer, at least two (2) other Board Members and such other persons as deemed necessary appointed by the President. The Treasurer of the Arts Council shall Chair the Finance Committee.
- ii. Duties: The Finance Committee shall be responsible for the preparation and monitoring of the annual budget, investment of Art Council funds, and shall make such financial reports as is deemed appropriate.

#### d. Personnel Committee

- i. Composition: The Personnel Committee shall be composed of at least four (4) Board members.
- ii. Duties: The Personnel Committee shall:
  - (a) Review and recommend all policies regarding employee relations and other related matters to be approved by the Arts Council;
  - (b) Ensure that all policies are implemented according to legal standards
  - (c) Conduct an annual evaluation of the Executive Director
  - (d) Be responsible for developing a description of job responsibilities, and the system to be used for job evaluations, as to the Arts Council Executive Director and all other staff.

#### e. Arts Education Committee

- i. Composition: The Arts Education Committee shall be composed of at least three (3) Board members and at least one (1) non Board member. The Executive Director shall be a non-voting ex-officio member of the Committee, as shall the Arts Education Director or, in the absence of a staff member in that position, any other staff member designated by the Committee Chair.
- ii. Purpose: The purpose of the Arts Education Committee shall be to develop and help provide educational learning experiences to supplement and complement existing art education curriculum in the area served by the Arts Council, and particularly in

Vanderburgh County, Indiana for students in levels kindergarten through twelfth grade.

- iii. Duties: The Arts Education Committee shall:
  - (a) Recommend to the Board policies, guidelines and opportunities for arts education programming
  - (b) Recommend to the Board policies and guidelines for disbursement of monies allocated to the Arts Council for the purpose of providing arts education.
- g. Gallery Advisory Committee
  - i. Composition: The Gallery Advisory Committee shall be composed of four (4) Board members.
  - ii. Duties: The Gallery Advisory Committee shall be responsible for developing and executing policy guidelines for, and reviewing submissions to, exhibits in the Bower-Suhrheinrich Foundation Gallery. It may also provide similar services for Arts Council sponsored exhibits in other locations.
- h. Other Committees

Other Committees may be appointed by the President as are necessary to fulfill the mission of the Arts Council.

#### **ARTICLE VIII. Financial Administration**

8.01 Fiscal Year

The fiscal year of the Arts Council shall end on the last day of June.

- 8.02 Investments and Depositories
  - a. Rules: The Board shall make such rules as in its judgment are necessary concerning the receiving, the banking and the disbursing of funds, and the handling of any other business of the Arts Council.
  - b. Signatures: Authorized signatures for any bank or investment account shall be any two of the following: President, President-Elect, Secretary, Treasurer or Executive Director. The Executive Director may sign checks without additional signatories only if done so in accordance with current Board approved policies.

#### 8.03 Audit

The accounts of the Arts Council shall be audited by an independent certified public accountant appointed by the Board at the end of each fiscal year, and at such other times as are deemed appropriate. The report of the auditor shall be presented to the Board for adoption each fiscal year.

# **ARTICLE IX. Agents and Employees**

#### 9.01 Executive Director

- a. An Executive Director or similarly titled administrative director shall be hired by the Board, serves at the discretion of the Board, and serves as an ex-officio, non-voting member of the Board.
- b. Duties: The Executive Director shall attend all Board meetings, and has day-to-day responsibility for the operation of the affairs of the Arts Council, including (without limiting):
  - i. Carrying out the Arts Council's mission, purpose and objectives;
  - ii. Execution of the Arts Council's policies and procedures; and
  - iii. Management of all Arts Council staff and volunteers.
- c. Authority: The Executive Director shall have the authority to:
  - i. Hire, direct, and discharge all other agents and employees in positions approved by the Board; and
  - ii. Perform such duties as may be required to carry out the operations of the Arts Council.

9.02 Removal: Any employee or agent may be removed at any time with or without cause. Removal shall be without prejudice to such person's contract rights, if any, and the appointment of such person shall not itself create contract rights.

### **ARTICLE X. Amendments**

These By-Laws may be amended or repealed, or new By-laws may be adopted, by a simple majority affirmative vote of Board members present at any regular, special or

Annual meeting of the Board, provided that the proposed amendment(s) has been presented to Board members within a reasonable time prior to vote.

# **ARTICLE XI. Parliamentary Authority**

The rules contained in the current edition of Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised, shall govern the Arts Council in all cases to which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with these By-Laws or any special rules of order the Arts Council may adopt.
