	The Teen Parenting Initiative Program (TPI) is a school-based birth to age three preventive program that provides comprehensive social service to teen parents and their young children. Robeson, located in the Englewood community, Hyde Park, located in the Hyde Park community, Banner, located in south Chicago, Simeon, located in West Chatham, Kenwood, located in Hyde Park, Farragut, located in the Little Village community, and Simpson, located in the Little Village community. TPI aims to prevent teen parents from dropping out of high school, while preventing secondary teen pregnancies and reducing the incidence of child maltreatment for their young children. It also promotes school readiness for the at-risk children,

40	Early Head Start (EHS) targets low-income pregnant women and families with children from birth through age 3, most of whom are at or below the federal poverty level or who are eligible for services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act. The program provides early, continuous, intensive, and comprehensive child development and family support services. The Early Head Start program utilizes the home-based service option this include weekly 90-minute home visits and two group socialization activities per month for parents and their children. Home visitors are required to have knowledge and experience in child development and early childhood education, principles of child health, safety, and nutrition, adult learning principles, and family dynamics

	siblings, etc.) in adjusting to the many challenges that accompany the role of relative caregiver. The goal is to stabilize families and keep children from entering the foster care system Next Step is a college-readiness program with mentoring support for pregnant and parenting teens. Next Step begins its college-readiness curriculum with teen girls and teen boys in their junior year of high school, continues services through high school graduation and provides limited assistance for them through college enrollment and first year attendance. Mentors include older college-educated professionals who are established in their careers, and peer mentors who are teen moms and dads in college, along with Next Step staff. The mentors work closely with the high school participants to offer a structured, interactive curriculum focused on preparation necessary for the teen parents' future of self-sufficiency. Teen Alliance is a small but highly intensive and individualized foster care program designed to provide care for a specialized female adolescent population. This is a group of foster children with highly traumatic and disruptive pasts whose needs are greater than can be provided for in a traditional foster home setting. These adolescents are placed in homes of dedicated professional foster parents who are hired by CCCS to provide an essential caretaking role. CCCS staff monitor these foster homes and provide needed supports such as counseling, mentoring, life skills groups and other activities.
