These surveys as well as the economic condition of Elmhurst College and other information concerning higher education are analyzed by the Human Resources Committee of the Board of Trustees with the assistance of the Vice President for Finance and Administration and periodically with input from an external consultant. The Human Resources Committee performs an annual formal evaluation process of the President in executive session. Performed in fiscal year 2013, every three years the committee performs an extensive evaluation involving various faculty, staff, students and external constituents. The Human Resources Committee recommends the salary revision to the full Board of Trustees who provides the final approval. Minutes of the Human Resources Committee document the determinations made during executive session.
