The college monitors conflicts of interest by sending out a questionnaire annually, as will as at every meeting the question is raised. If a conflict arises, that individual is prohibited from participating in the governing body's deliberations and decisions in the transaction under discussion.

Process for Determining Compensation	Form 990, Part VI, Line 15a	The Compensation Committee (a sub-committee of the Board) is responsible for determining the President's salary and reviewing the Vice Presidents' salaries. The Compensation Committee works with Human Resources (and possibly outside consultants) to obtain comparable salary/benefit data from organizations such as College and University Personnel Association (CUPA), in order to establish appropriate salary/benefit packages. The Compensation Committee consists of the Chair of the Board and two active trustees, who are not related to the President or Vice Presidents and do not perform management-directed services to the College. The College has an annual review of their compensation process. Annually, the Executive Committee reviews the Compensation Committee's recommendations and approves the President's compensation. The Vice Presidents' compensation is brought before the Board of Trustees in an executive session at the fall meeting. Contemporaneous documentation is maintained for all compensation decisions.
