Pursuant to section 704(b) regulations, allocations must either bear substantial economic effect or be in proportion to the partner's interest in the partnership. In either event, this would mean allocation of the first dollars of loss to reduce Technical Mechanical capital account to zero. Since the balance of the loss is in effect financed by non recourse deductions, the loss allocation is permissable to use any meaningful allocation of the partnership. Since Schiff would otherwise have 25% of the sharing ration, let's allocate the loss in excess of that amount allocated to Technical Mechanical 25% to Schiff and the balance to Technical Mechanical.
