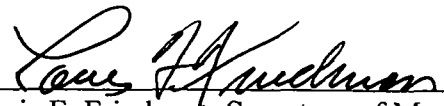
RESOLVED: That Thomas Carroll shall be removed from the Board of Directors effective immediately.
