The organization builds and sells homes to families in need. The organization completed the construction and sale of 12 homes during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013. Persons served totaled 17 adults and 24 children.

The 12 homes sold consist of the following demographics: 8 families were in the very low income category (&lt;50% AMI); 3 families were in the low income category (AMI 51-65%); 7 single parent families, 5 ethnic minority families; and 4 families with English as a second language.

The organization preserves existing homes for families in need. The organization completed the repair of 27 homes, including the homes of 3 veterans, 3 disabled, 11 elderly, and 4 single parent households. Eleven families were in the very low income category (&lt;50% AMI) and 11 families were in the low income category (AMI 51-65%).

Work in progress at June 30, 2013 included 11 homes.

Volunteer hours at fiscal year end totaled 56,433 by 2,151 volunteers.

After committee review, a copy of the return is sent to Members of the Board of Directors for their review before filing.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 12c-Each year when the financial audit is conducted, the Finance Director inquires of all officers, directors, trustees and key employees whether any conflicts of interest have occurred. Additionally, vendor and donor lists are reviewed to ascertain whether unreported conflicts of interest may exist. Potential conflicts are examined to determine whether these violate the Organization's policy.

Form 990, Part VI, Line 15a and b-The Organization has a compensation plan which establishes pay ranges for various classes of employees. Annually, compensation for all employees is reviewed by the executive management team. Raises are generally awarded based on cost of living, but department heads are allowed to spread raises unevenly through their department based upon merit, within strict limits. The compensation of the Executive Director is included in the compensation plan and the annual review. Wage and salary increases are presented in total and by department to the Board of Directors for approval along with the annual budget. Periodically the compensation plan is tested against information from a regional service bureau to ensure that wages and salaries are reasonable for the western North Carolina region. A report of this test is reviewed by the Board of Directors and was last made during the year ending June 30, 2007.
