The introductory paragraph, "I, the undersigned, a natural person at least twenty-one years of age, desire to form a nonprofit nonstick corporation pursuant to the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law of the State of California, and do hereby certify as follows" - has been deleted.

#### The FIRST Article has been amended to read:

The name of the corporation is the Seventh Generation Fund for Indigenous Peoples (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation").

#### The SECOND Article has been amended to read:

- A. This Corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.
- B. The specific purposes of the corporation are:
- (1) To engage in charitable activities related to improving the conditions, preserving the culture, and protecting the rights of Indigenous Peoples, communities/nations:
  - (a) to conduct and to sponsor programs of research, training and education in skills needed for such Indigenous communities/nations and to provide technical and financial assistance to local groups seeking to develop self-reliant Indigenous Peoples, communities/nations;
  - (b) to conduct and to sponsor workshops, meetings, and programs and to publish and distribute educational literature; and
  - (c) to conduct public education programs concerning the human, civil and other legal rights of Indigenous Peoples, and to provide advice and assistance to Indigenous People in matters affecting their general welfare and rights under the law.
- (2) to promote the development of economically self-sufficient Indigenous communities/nations.
- (3) to promote the spiritual, cultural and physical well-being of the Native family through assisting the charitable activities and projects that are initiated and controlled by Indigenous women.
- (4) to support and assist other organizations that are organized and operated for similar purposes, and to promote, encourage and foster other similar charitable activities.

- (5) to do any and all lawful acts and things which may be necessary, useful, suitable, or proper for the furtherance or accomplishment of the purposes of the Corporation.
