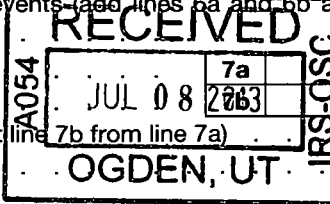



All related business activity was thus not reportable as taxable, as defined by the IRS, and no Form 990-T was prepared.**
