All members of the board received copies of the full 990 and schedules prior to submittal and had the option to review or not. 3. Part VI. Item 12. Conflict of Interest for board members. Once a year all board members are sent a new conflict of interest form to review, complete, and submit to the organization. Should a conflict of interest be perceived or anticipated this is subject for discussion at the committee or full board level. To date this situation has not occurred. 4. Part VI. Item 15. Determination of salaries for staff. Every three years the staff gathers comparables on similar positions in the nonprofit and governmental sectors. These are submitted to the Executive Committee and then the board for review. If indicated, salary ranges for staff may be altered. A review of outside comparisons for staff positions was completed in 2013 and a few changes were made. The Executive Director's performance is reviewed by the board annually and any decisions made about pay increases are made by the Executive Committee. The Executive Director reviews the performance of most of the staff and makes pay changes based on the budget and salary ranges when funds are available. Two staff members are reviewed by the Associate Director.
