

EXHIBIT A

AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF IMPACT OF SOUTHERN ARIZONA

These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation supersede and take the place of the heretofore existing Articles of Incorporation and any amendments or restatements thereof, all pursuant to the Arizona Nonprofit Corporation Act, §§ 10-3101 through 10-11702 of the Arizona Revised Statutes (hereinafter the "ANCA").

Article I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be IMPACT OF SOUTHERN ARIZONA.

Article II - Purpose

The purpose for which this corporation is organized is the transaction of any and all lawful business for which nonprofit corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Arizona. This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that quality as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws), or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws).

Article III – Character of Affairs

The character of affairs of the corporation is to promote the social, physical and mental health of residents of the greater Tucson, Arlzona area by providing assistance, services, support and referrals to the community. The corporation will be dedicated to identifying, coordinating and facilitating the delivery of a broad range of prevention and intervention projects within the areas of health and social services.

Article IV – Activities and Restrictions

No dividends, liquidating dividends, or distributions shall be declared or paid by the corporation to any private individual or officer or director of the corporation. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for

services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III above. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of any statements) any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws); or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws).

Article V - Dissolution

In the event of the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, distribute all of the assets of the corporation exclusively to one or more organizations then described in I.R.C. §§ 170(c)(2), 501(c)(3), 2055(a)(2) and 2522(a)(2) having purposes substantially similar to those of the corporation (except that no private foundation as defined by I.R.C. § 509(a) shall be a recipient) or to one or more units or agencies of federal, state or local government to be used exclusively for public purposes, as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so distributed, shall be distributed by the Superior Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, to one or more such organizations, units or agencies of federal, state or local government, as said Court shall determine as having purposes substantially similar to those of the corporation (except that no private foundation as defined by I.R.C. § 509(a) shall be a recipient).

Article VI -Board of Directors

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors, which shall consist of such number of persons as shall be fixed by the corporation's Bylaws from time to time, but shall not be less than the number of directors required by the ANCA. The terms of office, qualifications and method of election of the Directors shall be as specified in the Bylaws.

Article VII – Known Place of Business

The street address of the known place of business of the corporation is: 3535 E. Hawser St., Catalina, AZ 85739.

Article VIII - Statutory Agent

The name and address of the statutory agent of the corporation is:

Article IX - Nondiscrimination

The corporation will not practice or permit discrimination on the basis of sex, age, race, national origin, religion, or physical handicap or disability.

Article X - Membership

The corporation shall not have members as defined in A.R.S. § 10-3140(35) and the power, authority and right to vote for the election of Directors or officers of the corporation shall vest in the corporation's Board of Directors. The Board of Directors may, however, designate supporters of the corporation or others by use of the term "members", without such persons having the right to vote for the election of a Director or officers or without other power or authority.

Article XI — Elimination of Director and Officer Liability and Exemption of Private Property

To the fullest extent permitted by the ANCA as the same exists or may be hereafter amended, no Director or officer of the corporation shall be liable to the corporation for monetary damages for any action taken or any fallure to take any action as a Director or officer. No repeal, amendment or modification of this article, whether direct or indirect, shall eliminate or reduce its effect with respect to any act or failure to take any action as a Director or officer of the corporation occurring prior to such repeal, amendment or modification. The incorporators, directors, officers, employees and agents of the corporation and their property shall be forever exempt from liability or assessment for the corporation's debts, obligations, or engagements.

Article XII -- Indemnification

To the fullest extent permitted by the ANCA as the same exist or may be hereafter amended, the corporation shall indemnify and advance expenses to any person who incurs expenses or liabilities by reason of the fact he or she is or was an officer, director, employee or agent of the corporation or is or was serving at the request of the corporation as a director, officer, employee or agent of another foreign or domestic corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, employee benefit plan or

other entity. The foregoing indemnification and advancement of expenses shall be mandatory in all circumstances in which the same are permitted by law. No repeal, amendment or modification of this article, whether direct or indirect, shall eliminate or reduce its effect with respect to any matter giving rise to indemnification and advancement of expenses occurring prior to such repeal, amendment or modification.

Article XIII - Amendment

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by the Directors of the corporation by vote of a majority of the number of Directors in office at the time that the amendment is adopted, provided that no amendment shall substantially change the original purposes or character of affairs of the corporation. In the event of any conflict between these Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws of the corporation, these Articles of Incorporation shall control.
