health, and recreation to support a balanced lifestyle.

During 2012-2013, Heber Valley Medical Center's philanthropic efforts were centered around a \$900,000 capital campaign for Dialysis Services. Due to the success of the health committee's efforts, over \$195,000 was donated to the foundation for the construction of the dialysis center at Heber Valley Medical Center. During the fiscal year ending 06-30-14, a check will be issued to the Heber Valley Medical Center. The Dialysis center will begin treating patients in March 2014.

past, WCF has sponsored career exploration trips to New York City to visit
the three broadcasting networks and "Close Up" in Washington, DC for an
inside look at their democracy and view of government.

5.Ace Awards Program (Amount Expended \$6,035 14 Educators honored). This

program recognizes our local teachers and staff for their dedicated service to our children. During the school year, one teacher and one staff member from 7 district schools are honored with a \$100 check. At the end of the school year, a recognition night is held where the community honors each "Ace." From the 14 school winners, one is chosen to receive a \$1000 award as "Educator of the Year" and one runner-up is awarded \$200. Two staff members are chosen that night. One is selected as the "Classified Employee of the Year" and the other as runner-up, each receiving \$1000 and \$200, respectively.

- 6. Food Revolution (Amount Expended \$2,113, community served). This new initiative teaches and rewards students for healthy eating and living. A garden was planted at one elementary school.
- 7. The Arts Committee encourages, fosters, and supports the visual and performing arts in Heber Valley. WCF promotes Heber Valley as an arts destination location. The annual summer time "Concerts in the Park" is a supported program. The committee is looking for a long-term arts facility with expansion capability. (Amount expended \$12,578 whole community served)
- 8. The Recreation Committee supports the county's recreation center as more activities and programs are added. A local baseball team traveled to NY for competition. (Amount expended \$2,600 whole community served)
  9. Overhead allocated to Program Service Expenses (\$2,900).
