INCOME-FINANCIAL STABILITY Spokane County United Way coordinates the Spokane County CASH Coalition (CASH stands for Creating Assets, Savings & Hope)

Members of the CASH Coalition include representatives from financial institutions, social service providers, education partners and government agencies. Their wor encompasses financial education and counseling, second chance banking, and free tax preparation. Last year, 326 people received one-on-one financial coaching,

Members of the CASH Coalition include representatives from financial institutions, social service providers, education partners and government agencies. Their work encompasses financial education and counseling, second chance banking, and free tax preparation. Last year, 326 people received one-on-one financial coaching, 780 individuals received basic money management and credit classes, an estimated 500 individuals took advantage of targeted second-chance banking programs, and 5,053 individuals received free tax preparation services. The YWCA's Women's Opportunity Center provided financial education to 403 economically disadvantaged women, 328 of whom reported having acquired skills to increase their personal assets. Through the services of SNAP Financial Access, 35 program participants purchased a home, 122 foreclosures were prevented, 109 individuals developed personal debt reduction plans, 69 business/consumer loans were made, and 45 people started or expanded a small business.

INCOME - BASIC NEEDS The United Way funds in part the American Indian Community Center, which last year provided food assistance and meals to 3,015 adults, including 817 seniors. Our collaboration with the Martin Luther King Jr. Family Emergency Services Program enabled 120 families to receive emergency financial help to cover rent, utilities, and other basic needs. United Way funded in part the Salvation Army's Housing Stabilization and Empowerment Program (HS&E). HS&E provides a continuum of services, ranging from basic needs and emergency/prevention services to shelter, transitional housing, and aftercare, while providing case management and crisis management for all. Last year, the program fed 12,995 individuals, provided shelter or transitional housing to 174 households, and provided 555 households with life skills and employment training skills. United Way also provides funding to Second Harvest, which provided food to 114 regional food banks, meal centers, and youth programs.
