	Pesticide Reform (CPR185 groups across the state, among which PAN is one of the leading members in policy advocacy work). In
	the last year CPR and PAN have worked with the state to promote sustainable alternatives to fumigants; CPR is managing a project in
	Kern and Fresno counties to overcome barriers preventing community members from reporting pesticide incidents and other pollutants, and leading a group of San Joaquin Valley organizations in promoting sustainable agriculture.
