Program Service Accomplishments 2012 – 2013

Our agency gauges our success by the continued quality of services we are able to provide to a number of people with developmental disabilities and the amount of training we are able to provide to our employees, families of the people we support, and other agencies throughout the state. The agency was founded with the purpose of providing support services to individuals with developmental disabilities – intellectual disability, cerebral palsy, autism, etc. – who chose to live, work and recreate in the community in integrated settings. The agency supports and teaches individuals with disabilities who choose to live outside of traditional congregate living situations, work in meaningful jobs and participate in mainstream recreational activities that are available to people with or without disabilities. All of our training and support services are provided in community environments – grocery stores, laundry mats, gyms, libraries, public buses, community colleges, etc. – or in the individual's home or apartment.

We have two types of direct supports that we are approved to provide by the State of California Department of Developmental Services. The first is Supported Living Services. The typical ratio in this service is one trainer to one individual with disabilities. The services are centered around assisting and teaching individuals to locate and rent or purchase accessible and affordable housing, finding roommates, budget, shop, cook nutritious meals, do laundry and, very importantly, develop relationships and connections with community members and systems that the individual is interested in. The other direct service that we provide is Adaptive Skills Training. This is a daily (five days per week) program that assists people with things like job seeking, college classes, volunteer jobs, working out at the gym and other things that would typically happen during the day. This service is provided at a varied ratio with one trainer for one, two or three individuals depending on the activity.

In addition, we coordinate with other services such as In Home Support Services and Supported Employment agencies, medical providers and Regional Center to insure that the people we support receive all the services and supports they need.

Throughout the 2012 – 2013 fiscal year, Avenues Supported Living Services has provided assistance to 22 individuals in the Supported Living Services and approximately 30 individuals in Day Services. 12 of the individuals that receive Day Services also receive Supported Living Services in combination with the Day Services. Each of the people we support met goals and objectives they set specifically for themselves. Avenues Supported Living provided continued consulting to other agencies in the area of Behavior Assessment and Positive Behavior Supports. Increase requests for speaking engagements

at conferences, webinars and staff training for other agencies were attended by individuals or panels as availability permitted.

Although we had a bit of growth in the number of staff we employ, we were able to retain a majority of our long term employees over the fiscal year as well as significantly increase the pool of employees. While turnover in this field is generally 300% per year, we had a very few number of our retained/long term employees leave the agency. The people we support also remained in our programs. We were able to maintain our staff benefits to include contributions to a Simple IRA, medical coverage, tuition reimbursement, vacation pay and sick pay as well as other benefits. This helped insure continued consistency.

We continue to work with the people we support in areas of affordable housing including applying for and maintaining Section 8 and pursuing home ownership. At this point one person we support owns her own mobile home and two others live in homes purchased by parents and set up in a trust for them.

Our executive Director sits on a number of Committees and Boards associated with disability issues and plans on continuing this endeavor in order to have a wider impact and knowledge base. We continue to send our employees and the people we support to conferences and training symposiums for the same reasons.

We have mentored two agencies into existence over the past ten years which benefits many people including those wanting services, the funding source, potential employees and owner/directors of new agencies. It opens up spots for people currently on waiting lists and offers more options for people seeking services. We are currently mentoring another agency which is focusing most of their efforts on day services and also provide limited supported living services. Much of our growth in number of employees has come from the growth of this part of the agency. As of July, 2012, we were supporting 13 people in the day services and 1 person in supported living under this department. In June, 2013 there were 21 people in the day program and 1 in supported living. Upon their branching off, we will retain 21 of our current consumers in Supported Living and 17 in Day Services.

Our main goal for the next fiscal year is to reduce the number of people we support to under 25 and create a plan for the next five years. We hope to put more time into end-of-life planning and assistive technology for the people we support. We will continue to attend and present at conferences, webinars and symposiums related to this field and consult with other agencies as requested.
