with the Bylaws, grant funds are appropriated by the Executive Council to each Unit at the Elementary, Middle and High School. Each Unit
has a council consisting of elected parent representatives and school faculty and administrative staff. These councils review grant
applications and decide on award levels, based on the merit of the proposal Listing of grant requests are attached as Exhibit 1.
Part III, 4b: To insure that all students of the Kapālama Campus receive benefits from KS ATP, a \$4 per student fund was created. The
amount per student increased from \$2 to \$4 in FY 2008. Typical uses of these monies include grade level activities such as movies and class
picnics. These funds are accessed by parents and staff members via the Parent Coordinator and a subcommittee of Board members.
In addition, KS ATP provides several service programs including Spirit Night and Sunset on Konia.
Part III, 4c: The Kamehameha Schools Association of Teachers and Parent's Kökua Fund serves students with indigent backgrounds who
have special or emergency financial needs. The Fund is administered by the Assistant Treasurer, who in turn receives requests and
recommendations from the respective school principals, vice principals and counselors. \$3,597 in designated contributions was received
during FY2012 for the Kokua Fund. Typical uses of the Fund include grants to needy students who cannot afford dress whites, shoes,
school uniforms, school supplies or to pay minor outstanding tuition balances at year end. Although all of the recipients are on full
financial aid, financial aid limitations do not cover certain types of expenditures. Books, dress whites, shoes, charges for lost student ID
cards, and other miscellaneous school charges are also not covered by Financial Aid. Kökua Funds are often used to cure billing
delinquencies which enables a senior to participate in commencement or keeps an underclassman enrolled.
The ATP also administers a Makana Fund for destitute students. Counselors and Administrators identify potential families in indigent
circumstances and ATP purchases \$100 gift cards from a local supermarket to provide a Christmas meal. The gift cards exclude purchases
alcohol and tobacco. KS staff members are solicited for Makana Fund donations; \$13,244 was received in FY2012.
Part VI, Section A: Seven members of the Board are KS employees: Principals of the High, Middle and Elementary School, Director of
Boarding and three Teacher representatives. The remaining nine members are parents.
All parents are dues paying members of ATP. Parents elect class representatives who in turn elect Unit Council Directors. Teacher
representatives elect Directors and Neighbor Island Presidents are designated directors.
