Project Grants support special, one-time events that complement or expand upon the regular cultural programming of the applying organization. These one-time grants do not exceed \$10,000. A committee comprised of community volunteers reviews project grant applications. The committee makes recommendations for project grant amounts to the Executive Committee for approval in September and February each year. ArtsWave mails the award check to recipients of project grants after their acceptance and submission of an "Evaluation Plan". "Evaluation Plans" are then compared to the "Evaluation Reports", submitted at the conclusion of the project, which help document the projects outcomes.

Restricted Grants are made in accordance with donors' wishes and align with community priorities in order to amplify impact and create results by working in partnership with others.
