AFTER HE WAS NOTIFIED THAT THE EXTENSION WAS NOT BEING ACCEPTED HE WENT TO WORK ON THE RETURN TO GET IT FINISHED. HE WAS MISSING ONE BROKERAGE STATEMENT SO THE RETURN WAS SET ASIDE TO BE WORKED ON WHEN THE FINAL INFORMATION WAS ACQUIRED. DURING THAT TIME HE HAD SURGERY AND WAS PUT BEHIND IN LARGE AMOUNT OF WORK. HE RECIEVED THE ADDITIONAL INFORMATION WHEN HE WAS WORKING ON GETTING READY FOR THE AUGUST 2014 WORK. WE HAVE NOW COMPLETED THIS RETURN AND REQUEST THAT THE PENALTIES BE ABATED. WE HAVE NOT BEEN LATE IN THE PAST AND WE ARE NOW PUTTING IN A COMPANY TICKLER SYSTEM THAT WILL MAKE SURE THAT THE RETURNS IS COMPLETED IN A TIMLY MANNER IN THE FUTURE BEFORE THE JANUARY 15TH DEADLINE. YOUR CONSIDERATION IN REGARDS TO THIS MATTER ARE GREATLY APPRECIATED.
