2) ARTS AND COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS GRANT APPLICANTS

Guidelines

- The Arts applicants should be Tulsa organizations that reflect the founder's love of music, the performing arts and the visual arts. The Foundation is primarily interested in encouraging the classical arts to grow and thrive in Tulsa.
- The Community Organization applicants should enhance the community of Tulsa. The Foundation is especially interested in programs that focus on women's economic independence and well-being.
- The Foundation funds only 501(c)(3) organizations.
- The Foundation focuses its community funding in the Tulsa Oklahoma geographic area.

Application Process

- To apply for a grant, the applicant must submit a brief proposal or letter containing background information about their organization, the specific dollar amount, and the purpose of their request.
- If the request is chosen for further consideration, the applicant for the organization will be asked to submit a detailed proposal. Using the Foundation's Grant Application Format, the proposal must include:
