will be given for applications requesting pre-production or development funds.
* AFS staff and Board Members and TFPF interns are ineligible to apply.
CRITERIA FOR REVIEW
Essential factors considered by panelists include:
* The quality of the proposed work based on the description, realistic budget,
and supporting materials
* The likelihood that the work will be completed.
* The applicant's demonstrated ability and creativity as seen in the representational
work (film video, or script) submitted.
APPLICATION PROCESS
Applicants are asked to submit:
* Application form and budget
* Project description (1-3 pages)
* Project timeline (1 page)
* Optional support material (no more than five pages)
* Proof of TX residency
* Video sample
* Treatment or script (optional)
