Masonicare is a parent holding company and support organization for its affiliate corporations (collectively referred to as "Masonicare" or the "System") Masonicare was organized in 1995 for the benefit of providing long range strategic and financial planning, policy development and support services for its affiliates which provide continuing care retirement services and other housing, healthcare and related services to older adults. Tracing itself to its predecessor, The Masonic Charity Foundation of Connecticut, the principal purposes of the corporate system are to aid, assist or support the aged, sick or infirm specified groups, and otherwise provide for the needs of an aging population. In furtherance of its traditional values, the mission of Masonicare is to enhance the quality of life by providing health, social and spiritual care throughout an individual's lifetime with emphasis on the needs of older persons. Masonicare will be recognized as an organization committed to establish

Masonicare provides management support for its affiliates who provide geriatric care services, hospital services, management services, fund raising services and investment management services. This is done with a view of furthering the long-range goals and traditional objectives and values of providing for the needs of an aging population. COMMUNITY BENEFIT 1 Masonicare provides free education and services to individuals and families throughout Connecticut. The Lunch and Learn Program is designed to provide seniors and others with education on health and wellness. Speakers are typically medical professionals from throughout the Masonicare continuum. The program reached 3,917 people at senior centers and public libraries in the towns of Cheshire, Cromwell, Hamden, Mansfield, Meriden, Monroe, Newtown, North Haven, Southbury and Wallingford. 2 Funded by The Masonic Charity Foundation of Connecticut, Masonic Community Services is a statewide outreach program available to all Connecticut residents. It offers information and guidance on a variety of programs and services including ConnPACE (Connecticut's pharmaceutical program), Medicare, Medicaid (Title 19) and Medicare Part D, Benefits eligibility, Caregiver assistance programs, State and federal programs and housing options. Representatives from Masonicare Community Services are available to provide assistance over the phone or in the home. In the year ending September 2013, Masonicare Community Services performed approximately 100 home visits. 3 Another valuable resource to the community is the Masonicare HelpLine. In addition to providing information about Masonicare's continuum of care, the HelpLine offers assistance in locating and utilizing services, agencies and programs in Connecticut that are beneficial to seniors. In 2013, the Masonicare Helpline received 11,876 inquiries. 4 Masonicare again partnered with the United Way for its annual Day of Caring, in which volunteers from local companies come together to help non-profit organizations in their communities. In September, employees in Wallingford cleaned the kitchen and performed maintenance on the grounds at Master's Manna, a local food pantry and resource center. 5 Masonicare also held blood pressure screenings, hearing screenings and senior health fairs throughout the state, and made its facilities available to many community organizations including the Commission on Aging, the Area Agency on Aging and the Alzheimer's Association. 6 For the year ended Sep 30, 2013 Masonicare and all of its affiliates across our continuum donated 3,876 hours of their time to benefit the community through home visits and educational programs. These donated staff hours had a monetary value of \$89,393 and touched 11,117 members of the community.
