The Alabama Council does many other projects throughout the year, from The Economics Challenge to the Economics Extravaganza (an all day workshop for teachers). We train teachers around the state offering free materials with the training so they can better incorporate financial responsibility and economics into their classrooms. This is where our other program expenses are spent. Most of the salaries are expended through direct work on our projects and not through administration. In regards to Part VIII, Line 2g., our program service revenue consists of activities regularly carried out as one our substantial exempt purposes. ACEE trained 445 teachers in 2012-13, which is a 32% increase over 2011-12. 48% of the teachers are from schools with 50% or more free/ reduced lunch rate. 41,819 students were impacted. Teachers showed an average of 25% increase in learning based on pre/post tests. 62% of Alabama school systems participated in ACEE programs and/or teacher workshops. Our largest program expenses are: Curriculum \$ 429,837, Prizes \$7,708 (for students involved in our contests), Stipends 47,350 (for teachers and/or students to travel to our workshops/state championships), Substitute Pay \$3,248 (some teachers cannot attend workshops without sub pay) and travel \$10,483 (mileage primarily for our trainers to go throughout the state). In terms Part VI, Section B, Line 11a, we provide a copy of the 990 to our board after it is filed. The Board Treasurer, Randy DeRieux goes over the form before it is filed. Anyone can request any of our governing documents, and ACEE will promptly send them.
