- 3. The funding policy for metropolitan Chicago has changed. Requests for funding will no longer be accepted unless invited (initiated) by the Foundation.
- 4. In general, as a matter of present policy, appeals for the following will be declined:

 - C. Scholarships, fellowships, loans, student aid and appeals from individuals.
 - D. Medical and scientific research.
 - E. Private elementary and secondary schools, colleges, universities, professional schools and trade organizations.
 - F. Films, program advertising, conferences, seminars, benefits and fundraising costs.
 - G. Start-up organizations, start-up programs, emergency funds, and deficit financing.
 - H. Lobbying-related or legislative activities.
 - I. Endowment funds and intermediary organizations.
