In a spirit of cooperation, mutual dedication and joint effort, the mission of the UAW Chrysler Skill Development and its governing body, the Joint Activities Board is to improve Chrysler's competitive position by establishing mutually agreed upon projects and training programs to increase product quality, employee job security and employee satisfaction from work.

WCMA/Skilled Trades - Training Costs - Instruction to Chrysler's UAW employees in skilled trades and other area. For example, there is a course on predictive maintenance using ultrasound techniques to predict mechanical failures. In addition, students learn to use infrared thermography to diagnose heat-related problems in equipment at the plants. In addition, there are courses offered for tool and die making, sheet metal fabrication, painting and welding and millwright core skills. This training enables UAW Chrysler students to gain experience in a variety of skilled trades disciplines which makes them increasingly more valuable to their work teams when they return to the plant floor. Other expenses include the production of promotional videos to enhance and support the training experience.

4b (Code:) (Expenses \$ 2,990,572 including grants of \$) (Revenue \$)

Renovations and building improvements at the the UAW Chrysler World Class Manufacturing Academy (WCMA). The WCMA is a state of the art training facility that allows UAW and Chrysler employees to study leading edge manufacturing techniques and gain hands-on experience with some of the latest technological innovations. Some of the areas of study include robotic welding, logistics planning, problem solving and quality analysis and improvement. The Academy also provides a Health and Safety Laboratory that allows students to simulate potential workplace accidents and devise avoidance and response strategies. In addition, the WCMA provides training in areas such as electrical, HVAC, machine repair and die making.

4c (Code:) (Expenses \$ 1,609,448 including grants of \$) (Revenue \$)

The UAW Chrysler Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) is a program that provides up to \$5,000 annually in tuition assistance to eligible. To be eligible for tuition assistance, an employee must have at least one year seniority with Chrysler and be enrolled in a job related degree seeking program. In addition, employees must earn satisfactory grades for each course in which they are enrolled. Should an employee have repeated grades of failing incomplete, an employee may become ineligible for additional tuition assistance. For the fiscal year ended on September 30, 2013, the UAW National Training Center awarded \$1,609,448 in tuition assistance to UAW Chrysler employees. This financial assistance covers expenses for items such as tuition, books and lab fees.

The Tuition Assistance Program is designed to provide tuition assistance to degree seeking UAW Chrysler employees in work related areas at accredited colleges and universities in the U.S. The maximum amount of tuition assistance that can be provided for to an individual during the year is \$5,000. Also, the Tuition Assistance team constantly monitors each application to ensure that it is for an accredited degree program and the degree is in a work related field. Moreover, the Tuition Assistance team also monitors the academic performance of tuition assistance recipients to ensure that they are earning passing grades and not dropping or discontinuing their classes. The selection process is fairly stringent with about 20% of tuition assistance requests being denied.
