High School Senior Scholarship recipients are selected each year by the administration of the community high schools. Scholarships are awarded to the students selected. The scholarships are submitted directly to the college/trade school of the student's choice.

Before/After Program grant underwrote educational enrichment classes and activities for students ages 3-7 conducted and monitored through the Grant Early Childhood Center. Student Enrichment Fund Grants of up to \$100 are provided in the fall to teachers who apply through CRCSD to CRCSDF for classroom-based funding. Student field trips are awarded upon requests submitted by teachers and principals through the Cedar Rapids Community School District (CRCSD).

SAFE Program is described in detail in Schedule O in response to Form 990, Part III, Question 4d. The programs are monitored by the CRCSD.

School Project Grants, ranging from \$500 to \$10,000, are provided in the spring to teachers for large, capital needs. The projects are recommended and monitored by the CRCSD.

Professional Enrichment Grants are awarded to community school district educators, who submit application for assistance in furthering their educational development.

The Foundation serves as the fiscal agent for various programs that have a relationship with the CRCSD in various capacities. The Foundation receives contributions for these programs

and dispenses the funds to support specific activities of the program's choosing within the CRCSD.
