NOTE 1 - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

Organization:

The Foundation for Excellence in Higher Education Inc. ("the Foundation") is a non-profit organization that works to contribute to higher education by implementing projects that educate young men and women in the Western intellectual tradition. Its method of reform is to sponsor the creation of Centers of Excellence next to or within elite universities to provide independent financial and administrative support to one or more accomplished, tenured faculty at those universities. The Foundation was incorporated in the State of New Jersey on October 26, 2013 under the non-profit statute of New Jersey.

Basis of accounting:

The financial statements of the Foundation have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

Financial statements presentation follows the recommendation of the Financial Accounting Standards Board in its accounting statement codification, FASB ASC 958-210, Financial Statements of Not-for-Profit Organizations. Under FASB ASC 958-210, the Organization is required to report information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets: unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets, and permanently restricted net assets.

Financial statements presentation follows the recommendation of the Financial Accounting Standards Board in its accounting statement codification, FASB ASC 958-605, Accounting for Contributions. Under FASB ASC 958-605, the Organization is required to report contributions based on permanent or temporary restrictions. See Note 3 for more details.

Use of estimates:

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions. This will affect the reported amounts of assets, liabilities, and net assets, disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements, and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from estimates.

Income tax status:

The Foundation has applied for tax exempt charitable organization under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and thus, it will be exempt from federal and State of New Jersey income taxes. Donations to the Foundation are deductible as charitable contributions, subject to Internal Revenue Code limitations.

NOTE 1 - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES: (Continued)

Cash and cash equivalents:

The Foundation considers all highly liquid investments with a maturity of three months or less when purchased to be cash equivalents for which fair value approximates carrying amount. There are no permanently restricted cash and cash equivalents as of and for the period ended September 30, 2013. Certificates of deposit are included in cash and cash equivalents.

NOTE 2 - INVESTMENTS (at market value):

Investments are comprised of equity securities traded publicly, and are available-for-sale. Investments are carried on the books and reported in the financial statements at fair market value. The carrying value of investments would be reduced if any market value declines are considered permanent. Investment fees for 2013 were \$2,045. All investments are unrestricted and are summarized as follows as of September 30:

NOTE 3 - CONTRIBUTIONS:

Contributions are recorded as revenue upon receipt of cash or unconditional promises to give cash or other assets. Contributions are considered to be available for unrestricted use, or as designed by The Board of Directors, except funds specifically restricted by the donor. Grants and other contributions of cash and other assets are reported as temporarily restricted support if they are received with donor stipulations that limit the use of the donated assets. When a donor restriction expires, that is, when a stipulated time restriction ends or purpose restriction is accomplished, temporarily restricted net assets are released and reclassified to unrestricted net assets and reported in the statement of activities as net assets released from restrictions.

Contributions of donated non-cash assets are recorded at their fair values in the period received. Contributions of donated services that create or enhance non-financial assets or that require specialized skill, are recorded at fair values. Specialized skill services are typically purchased. The Foundation has paid for services requiring specific professional expertise during the period ended September 2013.

NOTE 4- GOVERNMENT AND FOUNDATION GRANTS:

There were no grants received during the statement period.

NOTE 5- UNCERTAIN TAX POSITIONS:

Management has adopted the provisions of FASB ASC 740 on its inception and this adoption of FASB ASC 740 resulted in no material adjustments to the organizations books. Management believes no uncertain or aggressive tax positions have been taken which would require such an adjustment. The organization had no penalties for the period ending September 30, 2013. The organization has the initial tax year ending September 30, 2013 that remains available for inspection by the Internal Revenue Service, and the State of New Jersey.

NOTE 6- CONCENTRATIONS:

Credit risk

The Foundation maintains its cash in bank deposits accounts, which at times, may exceed federally insured limits and to date they have not experienced any losses in such accounts. The Foundation believes it is not exposed to any significant risk on its cash accounts due to the increased FDIC insurance limits.

Currently the Foundation only has one donor as its revenue source. Grants and awards are only available for distribution from these funds and are expensed accordingly. The Foundation's operations will continue as long as donations remain available.

NOTE 7- SUPPLEMENTAL DISCLOSURE OF CASH FLOW INFORMATION:

Cash paid for income taxes and interest for the year ended September 30, 2013 was zero.

NOTE 8- SUBSEQUENT EVENTS:

Management has evaluated subsequent events from October 1, 2013 thru December 30, 2013, the date the financial statements were available to be issued. Management has not revised any estimates because of such events.
