I. Purpose: The purpose of this scholarship is to assist needy individuals to be able to

pursue an education at a post high school technical school, college (2-year or 4-year,) Community College, university, or accredited trade, industrial,

or technical institution.

II. Value The sum of the scholarship(s) will be not less than \$1,000, or may be a

greater amount, as determined by the Trustees.

III. Qualifications:

- 1. Recipient(s) should be a person(s) of high integrity, moral standards and ethical behavior.
- 2. It is preferred that the recipient(s) participated as a member(s) of a Wheeling Park High School sports program.
- 3. The recipient(s) must be either a graduating senior(s) or a graduate(s) of Wheeling Park High School.
- 4. The recipient(s) should have demonstrated a good academic achievement and the ability to succeed at an institution of higher learning.
- 5. Financial need should exist so that the awarding of the scholarship shall make a difference as to the recipient's(s') ability to pursue a higher education.
- 6. Grades are important, but shall not be the sole or overwhelming determinant in making the award(s). Great importance shall be given to the factors previously mentioned above.
- 7. It is not necessary that the student(s) attend a four-year college or university, junior college, or community college. Consideration shall also be given to those who express an interest in attending a program which leads to a job skill certification at an accredited trade, industrial, or technical institution.
- 8. Race, color, creed, national origin, gender, age, or physical disability shall not be considered as negative factors making the determination of the award(s). Equal opportunity shall be given to any student to make application and to be considered.
- 9. Previous recipients are eligible to re-apply for this scholarship throughout the course of their educational career.
- IV. Selection: The scholarship(s) will be awarded upon the recommendation of the Trustees, who shall also be responsible for any follow-up actions.
- V. Applications: Application blanks may be secured from the Guidance Department of the Wheeling Park High School. Completed applications **must** be returned to the Wheeling Park High School Guidance Department on or before **MARCH 31, 2013.**
- VI. Notification: The recipient(s) of the scholarship(s) will be notified at the Wheeling Park High Senior Awards ceremony.
