As the recommendations of this evaluation are implemented in the future, we will utilize the "Collective Impact" approach of a common agenda, shared measurement systems, mutually reinforcing activities, continuous communication and a backbone support organization to achieve our mission. As the lead agency, we are the backbone support organization coordinating systemic change through data evaluation, best practices, trainings and inclusion of all sectors of the community and providing overall oversight of the community's efforts to address and end homelessness. Effective December 10, 2013, the Organization changed its name to the Tampa Hillsborough Homeless Initiative, Inc.
