Part III

Primary Exempt Purpose:

To provide needed supplemental financial support over and above budgeted governmental allocations, and others.

This support is by paying directly to the Library for their purchases of books, videos, publications data bases, etc.

Our two major sources of revenue are dues paid by members and from the operation of our Book Store in the library, which sells books, magazines, etc. to the public. All of the items sold have been donated for that purpose, by the general public.

All aspects of the operations are done wholly and completely by volunteers, without any remuneration of any kind.

The volunteers also pay for any individual purchases made from the book store.
