Much like Ronald McDonald House, the Frances Cheney Family Place is a home away from home for family of patients at RRMC. Over \$93,000 was donated this year to complete the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) remodel and expansion. This capital project almost doubles the overall size of the NICU and adds an additional 10 bassinets and giraffe beds. All new high efficiency lighting and patient monitoring systems are included in the project. Now completed, the overall increase in patient volume is expected to be modest, but the major focus of the new expansion is to increase the efficiency and quality of care to the babies and their families. Another major capital project includes the completion of the fundraising campaign to purchase a new \$5 million state-of-the-art radiation tomotherapy machine. Nearly \$41,000 was raised this year to complete the project. <u>In addition to donations for capital projects, the Asante Foundation also helps</u> support numerous clinical departments at RRMC.
