These individuals and families, who have fled to the United States for asylum, desperately need food, medical care and psychological counseling to help heal the wounds and meet basic needs. (Code: ) (Expenses \$ 308,539 including grants of \$ ) (Revenue \$ Psychological Services - PTV served approximately 280 clients during the year. PTV provides psychological evaluation, individual & family therapy with the goal of increasing our clients' functional status; reducing their level of depression, anxiety and PTSD; enhance functioning of families of torture survivors, including reuniting with family members after long separation when survivors have fled their native country. As necessary, PTV refers clients to our pro-bono psychiatrists for evaluation and follow-up, with continued consultation & collaboration with the psychiatrist in the care of the client. We hold asylum readiness groups, which help PTV's clients understand and prepare for the asylum process. We have attorneys speak to the group to explain what will happen, what they can expect to go through, and answer any questions they may have. PTV's Healing Club, is an informal multi-cultural gathering of PTV clients, their families and PTV staff for peer and recreational activities. It provides the opportunity to share their culture through food, music, stories and build a sense of community and social support and to share their personal challenges and achievements. PTV has developed data collection on its clients for purposes of statistical tracking & measurement of outcomes. PTV sends in a significant amount of documentation & statistics from our ongoing work in semi-annual & annual reports to our major grant makers - Office of Refugee Resettlement (U.S. gov't) and the United Nations. This helps each of them in establishing guidelines for torture treatment. (Code: ) (Expenses \$ 154,270 including grants of \$ ) (Revenue \$ ) Medical Care - Most survivors of torture, who are new to the U.S., are not eligible for government or workplace health insurance until after asylum is granted - a process that usually takes several years. PTV provides free outpatient medical care at our offices inside the Venice Family Clinic, including referrals to medical specialists such as neurology, psychiatry, and gynecology. PTV provides immediate medical care by physicians who specialize in trauma. When specialists are needed, PTV utilizes the network we have created at Venice Family Clinic and at other local health care organizations, at no cost to our clients. PTV also offers emergency or trauma-related dental care through our partnership with the USC Dental Clinic. (Code: ) (Expenses \$ 61,126 including grants of \$ ) (Revenue \$ Case Management Services - PTV coordinates with staff members, our pro-bono professionals and other resources in the community to assist PTV clients in meeting their basic needs, responding to emergency situations, and in laying a foundation for clients to become/maintain self-sufficiency. The PTV Clinical Director, clinical staff, Medical Director, Staff Physician, and Case Manager meet 3 times a month for case conferences, assigning clients, planning for new clients, case review, presentation of lectures, articles & films of clinical interest. Some of the community resources PTV assists its clients with include food, clothing, emergency financial needs, transportation assistance, family reunification support and referrals for legal, housing, asylee/refugee benefits and job preparation and support services. Some of the specifics on these resources would include an on-site food bank, gift cards for groceries, bus tokens, non-profit housing assistance, including housing assistance to women and mothers, Section 8 housing, emergency shelters, transitional housing programs, job training through the California Employer Development Dept, LA County Dept of Social Services, International Rescue Committee, Jewish Family Services, Legal Aid, Los Angeles Housing Services, mental health clinics, and immigration clinics.
