The USGA provides grants to colleges and universities to finance turfgrass research and environmental research that may benefit golf courses. In all cases, staff monitors the use of funds to ensure that the grants are spent for the proper purposes and are not otherwise diverted from intended use. Monitoring normally includes formal periodic reports from the organization, detail program progress and use of funds. Monitoring can also include informal reports, depending on the nature of the grant and the organization it was distributed to. For example, grants to junior golf programs typically require the recipient organization to complete a formal assessment report that includes information about program outcomes, financial compliance, participant statistics, program schedule, instruction provided, and follow-up support. Such information is subject to audit, at the USGA's sole discretion. In all cases, unspent funds must be returned to the USGA. Grants to state and regional associations for golf administration internships typically require the recipient organization to complete a report describing the internship activities and accomplishments, and account for all internship salary payments. Additionally, the intern is required to complete an evaluation on their internship responsibilities and confirm the duration of their employment. Again, unspent funds must be returned to the USGA. Grants to colleges and universities for turfgrass research and environmental research typically require the recipient organization to complete a report describing in detail the results of the research, and account for all funds spent. Unspent funds must be returned to the USGA.
