ANY INDIVIDUAL, ORGANIZATION OR INSTITUTION, DOMESTIC OR FOREIGN, MAY SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A GRANT TO THE SELECTION COMMITTEE.
- 3. THE CRITERIA TO BE USED BY THE SELECTION COMMITTEE IN AWARDING A GRANT SHALL BE (A) A PROPOSAL WHICH, IN THE OPINION OF THE SELECTION COMMITTEE WILL PRODUCE AN IMPROVEMENT IN THE QUALITY OF AN EDUCATIONAL CURRICULUM OR SYSTEM WITHIN THE U.S. SCHOOL SYSTEM (GRADES K-12) NATIONWIDE, OR WITHIN ANY SCHOOL DISTRICT WITHIN THE U.S., AND (B) THE PROPOSAL IN THE OPINION OF THE

SELECTION COMMITTEE SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE ABLE TO PRODUCE A SIGNIFICANT POSITIVE CHANGE IN THE QUALITY OF EDUCATION FOR GRADES $\Breve{K}-12$.

- 4. GRANTS WILL BE AWARDED AT SUCH TIMES, IN SUCH AMOUNTS AND AND UPON SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE SELECTION COMMITTEE BY UNAMIMOUS VOTE SHALL FROM TIME TO TIME DETERMINE.
