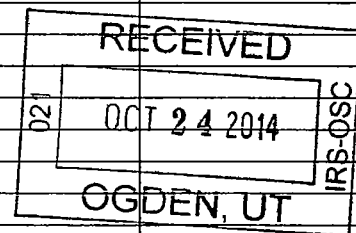

THE FOUNDATION BEGAN USING INVESTMENT MANAGERS IN FEBRUARY 2012, RESULTING IN AN OVERWHELMING INCREASE IN INVESTMENT ACTIVITY. TO DATE, THE FOUNDATION'S ACCOUNTANT HAS BEEN UNABLE TO PROPERLY RECORD ALL OF THE INVESTMENT ACTIVITY FOR THE TAX YEAR ENDED NOVEMBER 30, 2013.
