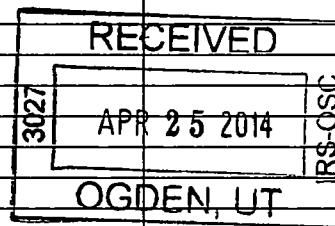

THE FOUNDATION WILL CONSIDER PROPOSALS THAT PROVIDE PUBLIC EDUCATION PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS THAT ENHANCE THE QUALITY OF LEARNING FOR ALL STUDENTS. THE FOUNDATION WORKS TO SUPPORT EFFORTS TO IMPROVE EDUCATIONAL SYSTEMS AND INDIVIDUAL SCHOOLS IN VULCAN'S COMMUNITIES BY PARTNERING WITH PUBLIC SCHOOLS LOCATED IN ITS OPERATING AREAS. VULCAN HAS ADOPTED 287 SCHOOLS IN ITS COMMUNITIES THROUGH SUPPORT FROM THE FOUNDATION. IT IS VULCAN'S GOAL TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF ITS SCHOOL PARTNERSHIPS EVERY YEAR.

THE FOUNDATION IS ALSO INTERESTED IN EFFORTS TO ENCOURAGE YOUNG PEOPLE TO DEVELOP AN INTEREST IN MATH, SCIENCE AND BUSINESS.
