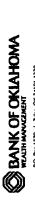

### Sarkeys Foundation Grant Guidelines

Proposal deadlines are February 1, 2013 and August 1, 2013, at 5 p.m.

#### I. Definition

The Sarkeys Foundation is a private, charitable foundation, incorporated under the laws of the State of Oklahoma and operated exclusively for providing support through gifts and grants to charitable, scientific, and educational institutions which are qualified under section 501(c)(3) and which are not private foundations within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Service Code of 1954 or comparable sections of the Internal Revenue Service Code added at a later date.

### II. Governing Body

The Foundation is administered by a Board of Trustees and an Executive Director.

#### III. Meetings

The Trustees meet quarterly in January, April, July and October. Grant proposals for 2013 will be considered at the April and October meetings.

#### IV. Response to Inquiries

A response to each request or inquiry will be made by the Foundation within a reasonable time.

#### V. Proposals

The Trustees invite proposals and applications from qualified charitable institutions. A careful evaluation of each such request will be made. Applicants are required to participate in a pre-grant interview with a program officer, at which time they will receive an access code for the online application. Nonprofit representatives are urged not to wait until the final deadline.

- A. Major areas of support by the Sarkeys Foundation include:
  - 1. Education;
  - 2. Social service and human service needs;
  - 3. Cultural and humanitarian programs of regional significance.

Sarkeys Foundation incurred program expenses during the year in carrying out the following primary activities:

A. In November 2013, the Southwest Regional Leadership Forum for nonprofit organizations, boards, community leaders and volunteers, was hosted by the Foundation. The Forum offered topics in leadership covering such specialized areas as risk management, board roles and responsibilities, ethical practices, development and fundraising, public relations, and strategic planning. Some 600 registrants, presenters and volunteers participated in the two day conference.

# **Total Southwest Regional Leadership Forum Expenses** 140,617

B. The Foundation's conference center, in addition to holding training seminars and workshops, is available for use by nonprofit organizations for meeting space. State-of-the-art audio visual equipment is available to users of the conference center. The Foundation's nonprofit library is also available for research or to hold events for smaller groups.

# **Total Conference Center Expenses** 18,975

C. Property expenses and upkeep of offices plus minor furniture and fixtures and supplies to assist nonprofit organizations, providing office space, and a conference center to public charities. A three-year lease agreement was renewed in 2013 with Big Brothers/Big Sisters of Cleveland County and Meals on Wheels for office space at below market cost. The Sarkeys staff also provides outreach services by conducting nonprofit board trainings, facilitiating board retreats, and hosting grant writing workshops.
