ELIGIBILITY

Applicants to the Hannaford Scholarship Program must be -

- Full-time or part-time associates of Hannaford or dependent children* of associates with a minimum of six-months service
 as of the application deadline date, and
 - *Child is defined as the son, daughter, stepson, stepdaughter, legally adopted child or legal ward supported principally by the associate.
- High school seniors or graduates planning to enroll or students already enrolled in full-time study leading to a baccalaureate
 or master's degree at an accredited college or university, an associate degree at a junior or community college, or a
 certificate at an approved vocational-technical institute.

AWARDS

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive an award ranging from \$2,000 to \$5,000. Up to fifty scholarships may be awarded each year.

APPLICATION

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE FINANCIAL DATA SECTION OF THE APPLICATION

The Financial Data section of the application should be completed by parents, guardians, *or* by the applicant if independent. Independent is defined as one who is **not** claimed as a dependent by the parent/guardian for tax purposes. Information should be from a completed tax return filed with the IRS.

- 1. State of Residence is the state where the parents and/or (independent) applicant reside and pay state income tax.
- 2. Adjusted Gross Income can be found on IRS FORM 1040 and is gross income reduced by specific adjustments allowed by law
- 3. **Total Federal Tax Paid** includes the total amount of **federal** income tax to be paid as reported on IRS FORM 1040. This is **not** the amount withheld from associate's paychecks. (The amount withheld should be adjusted by any refund or additional taxes due.) Do **not** report state income tax.
