Page 2, Part III. Item 4a

The HOPE Center Distribution Program. Food distribution is our largest program; we distribute food 3 days a week. In 2013 the Center provided a week of groceries for over 100,000 individuals struggling to feed their families. Of the individuals served, over 45,000 were children. One out of four children suffer from hunger in the Dallas/Fort Worth area.

Many of these people are unemployed, many are seniors on small, fixed incomes, and many are underemployed looking for better jobs. Some families support children whose parents are in prison. To determine their income level, each family is qualified by the TEXCAP eligibility guidelines for the State of Texas.

We also provided emergency food four days a week in Tarrant and Dallas Counties. To accomplish this, we partnered with Abundant Life Church in Dallas, with distribution from our facility in Fort Worth.

In addition to food, the Center also distributes donated clothes and shoes to individuals in need; this comes up often when a recipient looks for a job or finds employment. School clothes and school supplies are also distributed to children. During the Thanksgiving holiday over 1000 families receive turkey and dressing and all the trimmings to have a wonderful Thanksgiving meal with their families. During Christmas special holiday foods and toys for Christmas are also provided. We have a large toy distribution for the children of families registered for food assistance. Toys are given to the parents so they can plan "Santa" in their homes for their children to have the JOY of a surprise on Christmas morning.

Page 2, Part III. Item 4b

The School of HOPE was birthed to "Feed Hope" in the lives of individuals who seek gainful employment. Since 2007 we have had tremendous growth not only in students, but in the depth and variety of courses offered. The school has offered OSHA Forklift Certifications for several years, and in 2013 we added Customer Service and Hospitality training by using Culinary Arts as the format for the training. Students earn ServSafe food managers certification plus the skills to become a server for restaurants, banquets, catering, and institutional food services. Cake decorating I, II, and III and Garde Manger was also added for providing foods and fruit arrangements for special events. The student focuses on providing creative foods for special celebrations that helps give an extra touch of hospitality for their guests. The students are finding job opportunities plentiful for the certifications that they are earning at the School of HOPE.

The 357 students received their OSHA certification and 70% of them found job placement. The Customer Service and Hospitality classes opened in Oct 2013 and graduated 8 students of which 80% found employment. All classes offered in the School of HOPE are approved by the Texas Workforce Commission.

Page 2. Part III 4c

The Hope SMILE Center was opened for the purpose of bring HOPE to individuals who had lost their smile due to broken, decayed or missing teeth. It is very difficult to find a job if their smiles had been destroyed because of in these condition. The Hope SMILE Center focuses on individuals who are trying to find employment and can't because of the handicap of a degenerated teeth preventing them from having a nice smile. Often the gum disease causes an individual to lose their teeth and also causes their breath to be so bad that finding employment is difficult. So the Hope SMILE Center focuses on overcoming these hindrances that prevent individuals from finding employment. In 2013 over 50 smiles were restored by either restoring their smile with bridges or a complete new set of dentures. It was an exciting time to see these lives change when they were able to smile again and get back into the workforce to be able to get good jobs for their families.
