The MPC Common Grant Application (CGA) was developed by MPC grantmaker members with the goal of creating greater efficiencies in the grantseeking process and enhancing the quality of proposals grantmakers receive. An updated list of grantmakers accepting the MPC Common Grant Application is maintained on the MPC Web site. Please review this list and the grantmaker guidelines before completing an application.

The Maine Philanthropy Center is not a grantmaker. Please do not send grant proposals to MPC.

Getting Started

- 1. Conduct your research to determine those grantmakers who provide support to your type of organization and the geographic area your organization serves.
- 2. Visit the grantmaker's Web site or make contact to obtain specific guidelines. Do not submit an application without first reviewing the grantmaker's guidelines.
- 3. Review the List of Grantmakers Accepting the CGA to determine the appropriate application format.
- 4. A suggested page format includes 1-inch margins, at least 10-point font, and single line spacing.
- 5. Submit the number of proposal copies requested by the grantmaker.
- 6. If there are questions which do not pertain to your organization, please enter 'not applicable' or 'N/A' on the application form.
- 7. Do not include any attachments other than those requested by the grantmaker.
- 8. Once again, be sure you have carefully reviewed the grantmaker's guidelines!

Developing a Successful Grant Application

Know your organization. Clarify your organization's purpose and priorities in seeking funding. Make sure your project objectives are clearly articulated.

Be strategic. Research the grantmakers that make grants to your type of organization. The Maine Philanthropy Center is a valuable resource for local grantseekers. Visit the MPC Web site (www.mainephilanthropy.org) for further details or to make an appointment to use the resources.

- MPC offers an extensive reference library filled with information on local and national grantmakers.
- The *Directory of Maine Grantmakers* can be purchased through MPC. It is also available to MPC members in an online searchable format through the MPC Web site.
- Through access to FC Search, the Foundation Center's database on CD-ROM of corporate, private and public grantmakers, MPC provides Maine with continually updated funding information.

Know your grantmaker. Become familiar with the guidelines, giving priorities and application instructions.

- Review the Web site and make sure you understand the various application processes. Some grantmakers do not accept full proposals without an initial letter or call.
- Be sure your proposal is a good fit with the grantmaker's priorities; if the grantmaker does not think your organization is a good match, the proposal will not be considered for funding.
- If the grantmaker doesn't have a Web site, view the past 2-3 years of the 990 tax forms for a list of grants (See Foundation Center www.foundationcenter.org or Guidestar www.guidestar.org)



Using the MPC Common Grant Application

The MPC Common Grant Application consists of a Request Form accompanied by either Application A **OR** Application B, depending upon the dollar amount requested. To determine which application to submit, please refer to the List of Grantmakers Accepting the CGA on the MPC Web site.

Request Form. The Request Form provides essential data about your request and your organization. Begin by opening the Request Form, saving it (a writable Microsoft Word document) to your computer and entering your information.

Use the Tab button to move through the various fields to enter the required information. Areas shaded in grey indicate areas where you can type. Don't forget to save the document to your computer. When the application is completed, email or print and mail it directly to the grantmaker. Also note that some grantmakers may require you to submit the Request Form as a letter of inquiry before being invited to submit Application A or B.

Applications A and B. Both Application A and Application B have similar components (see below), but the level of detail within the proposal narrative varies depending upon the dollar amount of the request. You can view specific proposal formats for A & B on the MPC Web site.

Preparing a Project/Program Budget. No single budget format will fit every project, but there are standard elements that grantmakers expect to find within a proposal budget.

- The project/program budget should be broken down based on project revenues and expenses and reflect a specific time frame for the request.
- The project/program budget should provide the total costs for operating the program and the total amount of funding from all sources, both projected and committed.

Application B Format

Cover Letter

Include a basic one-page cover letter that states the amount requested and provides a highly abbreviated description of the project.

Part 1: Proposal Narrative

Use 1-inch margins, at least 10-point font, and single line spacing. Some grantmakers may have specific page limits; consult grantmakers guidelines. The narrative should be <u>clear and concise</u> and focuses on the grant request and should include the following (if applicable):

a. Organization Information

- i. Description of the organization structure, board responsibilities, staff responsibilities, and level of volunteer involvement.
- ii. Description of the current programs, activities, and accomplishments.
- iii. Briefly discuss funding history; including both public and private funds.

b. Project Information

- i. Description of the project/program and its relation to the organization
 - Discuss the need/issue.
 - Indicate the organization's relevant experience to addressing the issue or need.
 - Describe the targeted population and geographic area and any special efforts to involve the constituents in the planning or implementation of the project.
- ii. Timeline and Implementation plans
 - Describe the goals and overall impact.
 - Outline the plans, timeline, and proposed staffing pattern for achieving the desired results.
 - Indicate other public or private organizations that are involved and the nature of their involvement.

iii. Budget and Fundraising strategy

- Discuss the projected expenses and sources of committed and anticipated revenue.
- Describe plans for generating other revenue and identify targeted private and public sector sources.
- Briefly note sources of committed support and any outstanding requests.
- Projected timeline for use of funds. Provide project start and end dates.



c. Outcomes and Sustainability

- i. Monitoring and Assessment
 - Discuss how the organization will assess what is working and what should be continued.
 - Indicate the criteria for success/progress and the process for measuring effectiveness.
 - Discuss the organization's plan for assessing progress toward goals and overall projected outcomes.

ii. Sustainability

- Describe how the organization will build upon and sustain what is learned after the grant period has ended.
- Indicate any plans to share with other organizations the knowledge gained and to engage them in future efforts.
- Discuss fundraising and revenue generating strategies.

Application A Format

Cover Letter

Include a basic one-page cover letter that states the amount requested and provides a highly abbreviated description of the project.

Part 1: Proposal Narrative

Submit a proposal narrative, not exceeding 2 pages or 1,000 words, with 1-inch margins, at-least10-point font, and single line spacing. The narrative should focus on the grant request and should include the following (if applicable):

- Proposed use of requested funds.
- Targeted population and geographic area to be served by this project/program.
- Desired outcomes and plans for achieving them.
- Plans for assessing progress toward goals.
- Other sources of support committed thus far.
- Projected timeline for use of funds. Provide project start and end dates (if applicable).

Part 2: Proposal Attachments

Attach copies of the following (those which apply to your request):

- Most recent financial statement (audited if available).
- A current organization operating budget with revenue and expenses
 - o If the request is for program support or capital need ALSO submit a detailed budget tied to the request.
- Current/Final 501 (c) (3) IRS determination letter.
- If the organization has a fiscal agent attach a copy of the letter of agreement between the organization and the fiscal agent and the fiscal agent's Current/Final 501 (c) (3) IRS determination letter.
