The Lakes Region Scholarship Foundation, a New Hampshire corporation, is a tax-exempt non-profit organization under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code Contributions to LRSF are tax deductible (as allowed by law) and are personally acknowledged From 1956 through 2013, a total of \$4,617,720 has been awarded to 4,328 recipients from 500 donors or donor funds (not including the thousands of individual donors to memorial funds, special fundraisers, etc) In 2013, \$238,820 was awarded to 308 students by 214 donors Approximately 65% of the scholarships were generated from earnings on endowment funds established from memorial offerings, specific bequests or special one-time donations The remaining scholarship funds were raised through our annual appeal to local donors Civic, community, school, theatrical, and church organizations, as well as many individuals and businesses graciously respond to our plea **The Lakes Region Scholarship Foundation is merely the conduit. Our generous donors and volunteer board members deserve the credit for this proud record of helping local students continue their education and fulfill their career goals.**

DONOR PROFILES

We believe it is important for recipients to have some knowledge of their donors and the reasons why the contributions were made or the endowment funds were established A fund profile is incorporated in the recipient's award packet and students are instructed to send thank-you notes directly to the donors Privacy of anonymous donors is always respected

DONORS DAY

Donors are invited to participate in the selection process by recommending recipients of their scholarship funds based on a roster of prescreened and pre-qualified candidates Donors receive informational, but not confidential, data about the candidates, such as name, address, high school, college major and rating given by the screening committee, to help them make their recommendations Donors Day is usually held on the last Wednesday (depending on the holiday) in May from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM If a donor is not able to participate, their preferences or restrictions are always honored

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Applicant Eligibility

Only one application is necessary to apply for all the scholarship funds administered by the Lakes Region Scholarship Foundation (with a few exceptions John Mullen Essay, Lakes Region Board of Realtors, Annalee Thorndike Art Competitions – see website) Following are general qualifications

- Graduates of Laconia, Gilford, or Belmont High Schools, which include residents of Laconia, Gilford, Belmont, Gilmanton and Canterbury, **or**
- Legal residents of Laconia, Gilford, or Belmont, **or**
- Qualification for specific donor preference or requirements For example, the Elsie McCarthy Willey Scholarship is for nursing (or medical related) students residing in Belknap County Please check our website for further details, or call 527-3533

Application Deadline & Availability

Completed and properly documented applications are due no later than **April 15th** of each year, along with a \$15.00 non-refundable application fee. A checklist is included to ensure that applicants have properly completed their application and have attached all the necessary forms Incomplete applications are disqualified

Screening Process

Three trustees screen each application on the basis of financial need, extra-curricular activities, scholastic rating, and theme, as follows

Financial Need is given an alpha rating

- **A** Greater financial need
- **B** Significant financial need
- **C** Some financial need*
- **D** No perceived financial need*

**A limited number of merit-based awards are also available.*

A numerical rating from: 1 (outstanding) to 5 (poor) is given to the following criteria

- **Academic achievement** (high school or college transcripts are required)
- **Extra-curricular activities** (involvement in community, high school, or college activities (including sports), special honors, self-help by employment, savings for college, etc)
- **Theme** (A statement of the student's plans for college, specific educational plans, career goals, and why chosen field of study is meaningful to student)

Each screening team of three trustees meets as a group to review their individual ratings and tally their team's final score for each application. Guidance department representatives are also consulted. The entire board of trustees then meets to evaluate the screening teams' final ratings and guidance recommendations. Unfortunately, we can't guarantee that each applicant will receive a scholarship. However, we do ensure – to the best of our ability – a conscientious, non-discriminatory, confidential and fair assessment of each application.

Amount of Awards

In general, award amounts are determined by the rating given by the screening committee, based on the need of the applicant and the quality of the application, as explained above, and the funds available.

Recipient Notification & Disbursement of Funds

Most students, who are graduating from high school, will be notified at their school's award night or graduation ceremony. All recipients will be notified by the end of June. A College Certification and Request for Disbursement form will be provided to the recipients, which they must present to their college for completion. Upon receipt of the executed form, LRSF will forward a check to the college, to be applied to the student's account and disbursed as half for each semester. For awards of \$300.00 or less, students may send us validation (copy of cancelled checks or receipts) that they have paid college-related expenses, such as tuition, books, supplies or equipment, and a check will be forwarded directly to them for reimbursement.

**BY-LAWS
of the
LAKES REGION SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION**

ARTICLE I: Name

The name of the corporation will be LAKES REGION SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION.

ARTICLE II: Mission

This Foundation is established for the promotion and encouragement of scholarships and opportunities for higher education among residents of the Lakes Region, as defined in the Donor Policy

ARTICLE III: Board of Trustees

Section 1: The Board

a) Composition and Election

The Board of Trustees is composed of a President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary and at least fifteen (15) but no more than twenty (20) trustees, including officers, whose respective terms will expire at the annual meeting.

b) Attendance and Vacancies

Three consecutive absences from meetings, unless excused by resolution of the Board of Trustees, will automatically constitute a resignation. The membership of any board member, who is absent three times during a calendar year, will be brought to the board for review. Trustee vacancies will be filled at the next annual meeting.

c) General Powers

The affairs of the Foundation will be managed by the Board of Trustees who will supervise and administer all funds, investments, gifts, and property of the Foundation. The Board of Trustees may accept on behalf of the Foundation any contribution, gift, bequest or devise for the general purposes or for any special purpose of the Foundation. It will further approve and certify to the Treasurer all expenditures to be made on behalf of the Foundation. Investments made by the Foundation will be in accordance with the guidelines as established by the Investment/Finance Committee.

d) Compensation

No Trustee of the Foundation will receive any salary or compensation for services. The administrative costs of the Foundation will be kept at an absolute minimum.

e) Term of Office

A Trustee's term will be for three (3) years, with a limit of three (3) terms, or nine (9) consecutive years. After an absence of one year, a trustee may again be appointed to the board.

f) Advisory Trustee

Any retiring board member who wishes to continue serving the Foundation in some capacity will be considered an Advisory Trustee. Advisory Trustees do not have voting rights and are not required to attend board meetings.

Section 2: The Meetings

a) Annual Meeting

The Annual Meeting of the Board of Trustees will be held during the first quarter of each year for the purpose of electing Officers and Trustees and for the transaction of any other business as may come before the Trustees

b) Trustee Meeting

Trustee meetings will be held at least quarterly, with other meetings being held as needed.

c) Special Meetings

Special Meetings of the Board of Trustees may be called by the President at any time or upon written petition of one-quarter (25%) of the Board.

d) Quorum

A simple majority of the Board of Trustees will constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. A simple majority will be determined by the number of Trustees.

e) Manner of Acting

The act of a simple majority of the Board of Trustees present at a meeting at which a quorum is present, will be the act of the Trustees.

f) Meeting Notification

Meeting Notification. No additional notice need be given of regularly scheduled meetings of which all trustees have been informed in advance. Reminders of regular periodic meetings may be transmitted by mail, email, fax, or telephone (at the discretion of each trustee).

Notice of special meetings, or changes in pre-scheduled meetings, must be mailed at least three days prior to the date of the meeting, or by telephone, or in person. Email or fax notifications are acceptable (at the discretion of each trustee) if receipt is confirmed.

ARTICLE IV: Conflict of Interest Policy

Section 1: Duty to Disclose and Voting Requirements

Any possible conflict of interest on the part of any member of the Board will be disclosed in writing to the entire Board and made a matter of record through an annual procedure and also when the interest involves a specific issue or transaction. Where the transaction involved exceeds five hundred dollars (\$500.00) but is less than five thousand dollars (\$5000.00) in a year, a two-thirds vote of the Board approving the transaction is required. When the transaction involved exceeds five thousand dollars (\$5000.00) in a year, then a two-thirds vote of the Board approving the transaction and publication of a legal notice in the local newspaper is required, together with written notice to the Director of Charitable Trusts, Attorney General's Office. The minutes of the meeting will reflect that a disclosure was made; that the interested Officer and all other members of the Board with a pecuniary transaction with the Foundation during the year were absent during both the discussion and the voting of the transaction; and the actual vote itself. Every new member of the Board will be advised of this policy upon entering the duties of his or her office, and will sign a statement acknowledging understanding of and agreement to this policy.

Section 2: Other Statutory Requirements

The Board will comply with all requirements of New Hampshire laws dealing with pecuniary benefit transactions (RSA 7:19, 11 and 292:6a), *the New Hampshire Uniform Management of Institutional Funds Act*, and all such laws are incorporated in full into and made a part of this policy statement. These requirements include, but are not limited to (i) absolute prohibition of any loans to any Board member of the charitable trust; (ii) prohibition of any sale or lease (for a term greater than five years) or conveyance of real estate from any Board member without the prior approval of the probate court. These requirements extend to both direct and indirect financial interests, as defined by the statutes.

Section 3: Appearance of Impropriety

Trustees need to be cognizant of the conflicts that may arise due to any appearance of impropriety. A situation may not necessarily be unlawful or otherwise prohibited, but it may by virtue of the usual public perception of that situation, have a strong probability of causing damage to the reputation of the Board or Foundation. This appearance of impropriety may result in the removal of the Trustee.

ARTICLE V: Officers

Section 1: Composition and Term

The Officers of the Foundation will be a President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. Officers will be elected by the Trustees at the Annual Meeting of the Foundation and will hold office for the term of two (2) years or until their successors are elected. No person will hold more than one office at the same time.

a) The President

The President will be the principal officer of the Foundation and will supervise and control all the business and affairs of the Foundation. He/She will preside at meetings of the Board of Trustees. He/She may sign any instruments which the Board of Trustees has authorized to be executed, and will perform all duties incident to the office of the President, and such other duties which may be prescribed by the Board of Trustees. The President will be a member of the Executive Committee and will chair the Committee.

b) The Vice President

The Vice President will exercise the powers and perform the duties of the President in the latter's absence; will perform such other duties as the President or the Board of Trustees will direct; and will be considered in succession to the Presidency. The Vice President will be a member of the Executive Committee.

c) The Secretary

The Secretary will keep a record of attendance at all meetings to resolve claims of voting privilege. The Secretary, when requested, may attest, in the name of the corporation, to the signatures of the Officers or to the authority for the execution of documents authorized by the Board of Trustees. The Secretary will affix the seal of the corporation thereto, upon all documents usually appertaining to the office of Secretary and have such other duties and powers as may be assigned from time to time by the Board of Trustees. In case the President and Vice President will be absent from any meeting of the Board of Trustees, the Secretary will preside. The Secretary will be a member of the Executive Committee. The Executive Director will ensure that necessary support is provided to the Secretary.

d) The Treasurer

The Treasurer will have such duties and powers as may be assigned from time to time by the Board of Trustees. The Treasurer will present a financial statement at times as directed by the Board. In case the President, Vice President and Secretary will be absent from any meeting of the Board of Trustees, the Treasurer will preside. The Treasurer will be a member of the Executive Committee and will chair the Finance/Investment Committee. The Executive Director will ensure that necessary support is provided to the Treasurer.

Section 2: Removal of an Officer & Vacancies

All Officers and statutory agents will be subject to suspension or removal from office at any time by a simple majority of the Board. Votes for suspension, removal or reinstatement from suspension will be by secret ballot. Any vacancies among the Officers will be filled by the Trustees for the remainder of the term.

ARTICLE VI: Executive Director

The Board of Trustees will have the authority to appoint an Executive Director who will serve at the pleasure of the Board. The Executive Director will hire support staff as needed with the approval of the Executive Committee and within the confines of the budget.

ARTICLE VII: Committees

Section 1: General

The President will have the authority to appoint such committees as deemed necessary or advisable.

Section 2: Standing Committees

Standing Committees are permanent committees that meet regularly to conduct assigned Board business. Unless otherwise specified, only Trustees may serve on Standing Committees. At the convenience of the Board, these committees may meet jointly with a common agenda. The following will consist of the Standing Committees of the Board and their respective memberships. The President and Executive Director may be included as ex-officio members of any standing committee.

- a) **The Executive Committee** will be chaired by the President of the Board and will be composed of the Officers of the Board.
- b) **The Nominating Committee** will include the trustees whose terms expire the year following the current year.
- c) **The Finance/Investment Committee** will be chaired by the Treasurer and will be composed of not less than three (3) Trustees, including the Treasurer.
- d) **The Screening Committee** will be appointed annually by the Board of Trustees and will be responsible for reviewing and grading scholarship applications. A Screening Committee Chairperson, who is responsible for coordinating the reviewing and grading of scholarship applications, will also be appointed by the Trustees. This committee and its Chairperson will consist of Officers, Trustees and Advisory Trustees.
- e) **The By-Laws Committee** will be appointed annually by the President and will consist of a minimum of three (3) Trustees.
- f) **The Development Committee** will plan and oversee the fund-raising activities of the Foundation.
- g) **The Audit Committee** will provide oversight of the Foundation's annual financial audit; review internal audit; recommend independent accounting firm to conduct audit to the full board for their approval, if or when applicable; assist board members of the Foundation in the effective discharge of their responsibilities by furnishing them with independent analysis, objective opinions, recommendations and pertinent comments concerning the activities reviewed.
- h) **The Scholarship Committee** will be chaired by the President of the Board and will be composed of all board members, as well as, one representative from each donor fund. The final roster of scholarship recipients, which were recommended by the board and donor representatives from a list of pre-qualified applicants, will be submitted to the Scholarship Committee for ratification in June each year.

Section 3: Ad Hoc Committees

Ad Hoc Committees are for one issue and/or narrow focus and are time-limited upon creation by the Board. They will terminate automatically at the Annual Meeting following their creation unless otherwise specified by the Board. Ad Hoc Committee members may include non-Board Trustees.

Section 4: Advisory Committees

Advisory Committees are created solely to advise the Board on a specific topic. They may report only, and the committees terminate automatically at the Annual Meeting following their creation unless otherwise specified by the Board. Advisory Committee membership may include non-Board Trustees.

ARTICLE VIII: By-Laws

The By-Laws are to be reviewed annually as directed by the President and may be altered, amended or repealed. New by-laws may be adopted at any regular meeting or at any special meeting of the Foundation called for that purpose. Changes will require a simple majority of the Board for adoption.

ARTICLE IX: Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the Foundation, no part of the assets of the Foundation will be distributed or will inure to the benefit of any Trustee of the Foundation. After payment of all outstanding liabilities, remaining funds will be used in full for the educational and scholarship purposes for which the Foundation was organized and operated. Said remaining assets will in no event, upon dissolution, be used in any manner except for such educational purposes as will meet with the requirements of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 as amended.
