Foundation Update: The Orchard Foundation will no longer accept unsolicited Concept Letters, Letters of inquiry, or Proposals. All funding in the future will be done on a Pre-Selected Organization (PSO) basis only. Occasionally, Request for Proposals (RFPs) may be sent to a select number of organizations.

If a Request for Proposal is sent to your organization, please read the following information:

Environment - The foundation funds in the following areas: air quality, global climate change, fresh and coastal waters and forests. The Orchard Foundation favors advocacy (principally legal, governmental agencies, and administrative process participation advocacy) projects.

Areas not funded: Given that the Orchard Foundation is a very small foundation, it is impossible to fund all projects that fall into our primary environmental program areas. Therefore it is easier to list some of the areas which the foundation board is not interested in funding. We will not be sending out RFPs for the following areas: general citizen organizing and public awareness-building projects, environmental education projects (for adults or children), ocean fisheries, growth management and sprawl, toxic substances and pollution prevention, animal rights, animal hospitals or rehabilitation centers, species specific projects, scientific research, and land acquisition.

Reproductive Rights - The foundation funds projects advocating for reproductive rights for adolescents, in addition to projects aiming for comprehensive sexuality education for middle and high school students.

Funding limitations: Most funding disbursed by the foundation is done on a designated giving basis only. These grants are at the discretion of the trustees and no correspondence concerning them will be considered.
