Summary of Accomplishments Fiscal Year 2013

hawkwing was begun in 1998 and received its non-profit status in 1999 in order to fulfill a promise Rochelle Ripley made to her Lakota Grandmother to "go home and help the People." Upon her first trip back to the Reservation in 1997 – 45 years after she made her promise at age 5 - Rochelle found conditions were much worse than she was expecting. The Reservation – the poorest place in America – was comparable to a third world nation. Poverty was everywhere – dilapidated housing, homelessness, hunger, a life expectance of only age 48, limited access to medical care and unemployment near 90%. She came home, recruited volunteers, worked with the Tribe to assess needs and developed a plan to help. Fifteen years later, hawkwing remains today an all volunteer organization in order to maximize donation resources for helping on the Reservation.

hawkwing has an outstanding record of success for the past 15 years. Starting in 2000, the "Annual Give Away" was launched to provide all Lakota children (about 2,600) an individually packed gift box for the holidays including the following new items: warm clothing (coats, tops, socks, gloves and more), two toys, two books, a package of school supplies and personal care products. This has totaled approximately 29,000 children's boxes worth some \$3.2 million over the 14 years. Additionally, they work closely with the schools providing books, food, calculators, dental services, equipment and computers. They sponsor youth summer reading camps including the distribution of books and offered photography class in the summer of 2014 to 15 older teens to foster career exploration and capture "Cheyenne River through the Eyes of its Children". These goods and services equal approximately \$130,000.

hawkwing brings volunteer doctors, dentists and other health professionals to offer care to children and women including securing \$600,000 worth of vitamins (2013-2015) in collaboration with Vitamin Angels and WIC, training and certifying first responders to increase infant survival rates, sponsoring medical clinics for women and children and conducting dental clinics focused on the schools and Head Start. They support the behavioral health clinic with information and detox-acupuncture. Some \$500,000 worth of medical equipment (wheelchairs, hospital beds, walkers, crutches and canes) has been donated including assistance to the Tribe to establish its first Diabetes Program with the set up of medical/exam rooms and equipment. This year included education, awareness and screenings for children and adults for scoliosis. Medical and dental services equal an additional \$1,200,000.

Working collaboratively with the military veterans, hawkwing volunteers provided training in how to build accessibility ramps for people with disabilities and arranged provision of wood and supplies needed for construction. The initial group receiving ramps included 17 disabled veterans who were housebound and this was followed by ramps for Elders, children and adults with disabilities. In one year, the veterans have stalled over 50 ramps. The veterans and hawkwing also collaborate each summer in a project called "Helping Hands" to provide home repairs for people in need including single mothers, Elders and veterans. Veterans assist hawkwing in distributing household goods and furniture as well. The value of the Helping Hands construction projects is about \$150,000.

When learning that many Elders did not have beds, hawkwing launched a successful drive to provide 283 Elders with new beds, frames, linens, blankets and pillows valued at \$150,000. hawkwing has also provided new carpets, new and used furniture, adult clothing and coats, boots and shoes, blankets, gift boxes for Elders, sports equipment, baby care products (diapers, clothes, furniture, formula), reading glasses, household products, Hunger is prevalent and hawkwing has launched several food initiatives: they administer the local food pantry in conjunction with the military veterans including fundraising to purchase needed food; delivering greenhouses to extend the short growing season; stimulating the creation of local gardens and are donating Tower Gardens (vertical aeroponic growing systems) for year round food production. The first three were delivered to Takini School in June 2014 where they will be for the breakfast and lunch program and incorporated into the school curriculum (science, home economics, agriculture). This is supported by grants from the Densford Fund of Riverside Church in New York for \$10,000 and Annie's Foods with a \$500 grant to develop the curriculum. They received a grant and recognition for "Seeds of Hope" (Wall Street Journal/Emerson Ecologics) for bringing supplies and training in growing sprouts – an easy and inexpensive ways to grow a healthy food item. hawkwing supports women's cottage industries and artist activities particularly focused on passing along traditional arts to the younger women. Finally, hawkwing received an International Telly Award for video production for the "Lakota Elders Video" – a project to preserve the traditional cultural ways and stories of the Elders on the Reservation. The video is used in the schools in the cultural and language programs. (note: The Telly Award is to video as the Oscar is to movies). The value of these programs is some \$45,000.

hawkwing was also the recipient of a \$500,000 five year federal grant that was matched with equal funds and services through the offices of Juvenile Justice and the Department of Health and Human Services from 2003 through 2008. This grant provided positive youth development in two Connecticut middle schools and used Native American storytelling as well as engaging students in service learning and action which linked the students in Connecticut with the students on the Reservation.

In total, the estimate for services and goods delivered to the Reservation since 2000 is \$8.9 million. This includes donations of cash and new items, household goods, medical/dental supplies and services, in-kind shipping (two semi-tractor trailer loads annually), in-kind rent, volunteer travel for service trips, educational services and supplies, construction materials, household goods, food and more. hawkwing engages thousands of volunteers and donors across 42 states and works with corporations, businesses, colleges, faith communities, foundations, schools, veterans, civic groups, women's associations and youth organizations.

In 2013, hawkwing became the fiduciary for SHIFT Scoliosis – a program assisting children and families with scoliosis and related conditions (Support, Help, Information for Transformation). They serve people located on the Cheyenne River Lakota Reservation as well as children worldwide.
