Form 990, Part III, Merger Activities	On November 30, 2012, with the unanimous consent of the Board of Directors, the Foundation entered into an agreement to merge with the Kids With Food Allergies Foundation (KFA), a not-for-profit corporation. This merger was approved by the New York state regulatory authorities and became effective July 22, 2013. Pursuant to the merger agreement, KFA's net assets of \$170,274 were contributed to the Foundation. The Foundation became the surviving corporation, and KFA ceased to exist. After the merger, KFA activities were combined with the Foundation.
