BY-LAWS

OF

HERBERT AND NELL SINGER FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE I - OFFICERS

1.1 The principal office of the corporation shall be where designated by a vote of the directors of the corporation. The corporation may also have offices at such other places within or without the State of New York as the Board may from time to time determine or the business of the corporation may require. [Amended April 2010]

<u>ARTICLE II – PURPOSES</u>

2.1 The purpose for which this corporation has been organized are as follows:

To receive and maintain a fund or funds of real or personal property or both, and subject to the restrictions and limitations set forth in the Certificate of Incorporation and the applicable provisions of the Internal Revenue Code and Regulations, to use and apply the whole or any part of the income there from and the principal thereof exclusively for charitable, religious, scientific, testing for public safety, literary or educational purposes by contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501© (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

<u>ARTICLE III – MEMBERSHIP</u>

3.1 The corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE IV – DIRECTORS AND MEETINGS

- 4.1 Management of the Corporation.
 - 4.1.1 The corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors which shall consist of not less than three (3) Directors. Each Director shall be at least nineteen (19) years of age. There shall be two classes of Directors: 1) "Related Directors" who shall be individuals who are related by blood or marriage to the founders of the Foundation, Nell and Herbert Singer; and 2) "Non-Related Directors" who shall be individuals who are not related to the founders. A majority of the Directors shall be Related Directors. (Amended March 9, 2011)

4.2 Election and Term of Directors.

4.2.1 Each Related Director shall hold office until his death, prior resignation or removal. Each Non-Related Director shall hold office for an initial term

- of three (3) years and shall be eligible for two additional three year terms by vote of the Board (Amended March 9, 2011)
- 4.2.2 Upon the death, resignation or incapacity of a Related Director, the surviving Directors, by a majority vote, or the sole surviving Director should there be only one Director, shall elect one or more Related Director(s) from among the Associate Directors hereinafter described and who have been previously elected. [Amended October 15, 2013]

4.3 Increase or Decrease in Number of Directors.

4.3.1 The total number of Directors may be increased or decreased by a vote of a majority of all of the Directors. No decrease in number of Directors shall shorten the term of any incumbent Director.(Amended March 9, 2011)

4.4 Newly Created Directorships and Vacancies.

4.4.1 Newly created Directorships resulting from an increase in the number of directors and vacancies occurring in the Board for any reason may be filled by a vote of majority of the Directors then in office, although less than a quorum exists.

4.5 Removal of Directors.

4.5.1 Any director may be removed for cause, or without cause, by action of a majority of the Directors then in office, other than the Director who may be removed. (Amended March 9, 2011)

4.6 Resignation.

4.6.1 A director may resign at any time by giving written notice to the Board, the President or the Secretary of the corporation. Unless otherwise specified in the notice, the resignation shall take effect upon receipt thereof by the Board or such officer, and the acceptance of the resignation shall not be necessary to make it effective.

4.7 Quorum of Directors.

4.7.1 Unless otherwise provided in the Certificate of Incorporation, a majority of the entire Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business or of any specified item of business. In the event that the number of Directors shall be an even number, 50% of the Directors shall constitute a quorum.

4.8 Action of the Board.

- 4.8.1 Unless otherwise required by law, the vote of a majority of the Directors present at the time of the vote, if a quorum is present at such time, shall be the act of the Board. Each Director present shall have one vote.
- 4.7.2 Any action required or permitted to be taken by the Board of Directors may be taken without a meeting if all members of the Board consent in writing to the adoption of a resolution authorizing the action. Resolution and the written consents shall be filed with the minutes of the Board proceedings.

4.9 Place and Time of Board Meetings.

4.9.1 The Board may hold its meetings at the office the corporation or at such other places, either within or without the State, as it may from time to time determine.

4.10 Regular Annual Meeting.

4.10.1A regular annual meeting of the Board shall be held on the fourth Friday of October each year or on such date as determined by the Board..(Amended March 9, 2011)

4.11 Notice of Meetings of the Board, Adjournment.

- 4.11.1 Regular meetings of the Board may be held at such time and place as the President, from time to time, shall determine, upon at least five (5) days' written and/or electronic notice to each Director, delivered personally, via facsimile or e-mail. Special meetings of the Board shall be held upon notice to the Directors and may be called by the President upon three days notice to each Director, either personally or by mail or by wire; special meetings shall be called by the president or by the Secretary in a like manner on written request of two Directors. Notice of a meeting need not be given to any Director who submits a waiver of notice whether before or after the meeting or who attends the meeting without protesting prior thereto or at its commencement, the lack of notice to him.[Amended October 15, 2013]
- 4.10.2 A majority of the Directors present, whether or not a quorum is present, may adjourn any meeting to another time and place. Notice of the adjournment shall be given all Directors who were absent at the time of the adjournment and, unless such time and place are announced at the meeting, to the other Directors.

4.12 Executive and other Committees.

4.12.1 The Board, by resolution adopted by a majority of the entire Board, may designate from among its members an Executive Committee consisting of two or more Directors and from among its members or non-members may

designate other Committees, each consisting of at least one Directors. Each such Committee shall serve at the pleasure of the Board. (Amended March 9, 2011)

- 4.13 Associate Directors [Amended October 15, 2013]
 - 4.13.1 The Board, by resolution adopted by the majority of the entire Board, may designate Associate Directors from among persons who are related by blood or marriage to the aforesaid Nell and Herbert Singer, who shall serve for a term of two (2) years. Such term of service may be extended for successive two-year terms upon a majority vote of the entire Board.[Amended October 15, 2013]
 - 4.13.2 Associate Directors shall be non-voting Members of the Board.[Amended October 15, 2013]
 - 4.13.3 Associate Directors shall be bound by all policies adopted by the Board. [Amended October 15, 2013]

ARTICLE V - OFFICERS

5.1 Offices, Election, Term.

5.1.1 Unless otherwise provided for in the Certificate of Incorporation, the Board may elect or appoint a president, one or more Vice-Presidents, a Secretary and a Treasurer, and such other officers as it may determine, who shall have such duties, powers and functions as hereinafter provided. All officers shall be elected or appointed to hold office until the meeting of the Board following the annual meeting of members. Each officer shall hold office for the term for which he is elected or appointed and qualified.

5.2 Removal, Resignation, Salary.

5.2.1 Any officer elected or appointed by the Board may be removed by the Board with or without cause. In the event of the death, resignation or removal of an officer, the Board in its discretion may elect or appoint a successor to fill the unexpired term. Any two or more offices may be held by the same person, except the offices of President and Secretary. The salaries of all officers shall be fixed by the Board.

5.3 President.

5.3.1 The President shall be the chief executive officer of the corporation; he shall preside at all meetings of the members and of the Board; he shall manage the affairs of the corporation and shall see that all orders and resolutions of the Board are carried into effect. (Amended March 9, 2011)

5.4 Vice-Presidents.

5.4.1 During the absence or disability of the President, the Vice-President, or if there are more than one, the executive Vice President, shall have all the powers and functions of the President. Each Vice-President shall perform such other duties as the Board shall prescribe.

5.5 Treasurer.

Unless otherwise provided by the Board, The Treasurer shall have the care and custody of all the funds and securities of the corporation, and shall deposit said funds in the name of the corporation in such bank, trust company or such custodian account as the Directors may elect; he shall, when duly authorized by the Board of Directors, sign and execute all contracts in the name of the corporation, when countersigned by the President; he shall also sign all checks. drafts, notes and orders for the payment of money, which shall be duly authorized by the Board of Directors; he shall at all reasonable times exhibit his books and accounts to any Director or member of the corporation upon application at the office of the corporation during ordinary business hours. Unless otherwise provided by the Board (Amended November 18, 20123), at the end of each corporate year, he shall arrange to have an audit of the accounts of the corporation made by an auditor selected by the Board of Directors and he shall arrange to have such audit presented in writing at the annual meeting of the members, at which time he also shall present an annual report setting forth in full the financial conditions of the corporation. (Amended March 9, 2011)

5.6 Assistant Treasurer.

5.6.1 During the absence or disability of the Treasurer, the Assistant Treasurer, or if there are more than one, the one so designed by the Secretary or by the Board, shall have the powers and functions of the Treasurer.

5.7 Secretary.

5.7.1 The Secretary shall keep the minutes of the Board of Directors. He shall have the custody of the seal of the corporation and shall affix and attest the same to documents when duly authorized by the Board of Directors. He shall attend to the giving and serving of all notices of the corporation, and shall have charge of such books and papers as the Board of Directors may direct; he shall attend to

such correspondence as may be assigned to him, and perform all the duties incidental to his office.

5.8 Assistant Secretaries.

5.8.1 During the absence or disability of the Secretary, the Assistant Secretary, or if there are more than one, the one so designated by the Secretary or by the Board, shall have all the powers and functions of the Secretary.

5.9 Sureties and Bonds.

5.9.1 In case the Board shall so require, any officer or agent of the corporation shall execute to the corporation a bond in such sum and with such surety or sureties as the Board may direct, conditioned upon the faithful performance of his duties to the corporation and including responsibility for negligence and for the accounting for all property, funds or securities of the corporation which may come into his hands.

6.1 The seal of the corporation shall be as follows:

7.1 If there be any conflict between the provisions of the Certificate of Incorporation and these By-Laws, the provisions of the Certificate of Incorporation shall govern.
