The reimbursement for those services amounted to \$105,000 and \$101,000 in 2013 and 2012, respectively. These transactions were eliminated in consolidation. Transactions between Word of Life and the Foundation in addition to those disclosed elsewhere in the footnotes at and during the year ended December 31, 2013, consisted of (1) contributions received from the Foundation totaling \$5,938,974, which includes \$3,000,000 of loan forgiveness, and (2) interest on the outstanding note payable paid to the Foundation totaling \$247,500.
